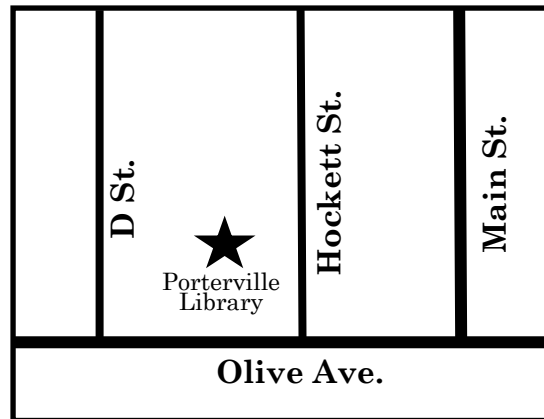


# Build your Reader!

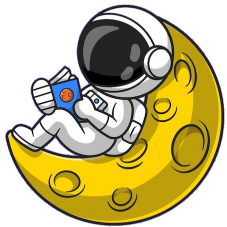

# 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten

**The “1,000 Books Before Kindergarten Challenge” is a Porterville City Library program that encourages all families and caregivers to read at least 1,000 books with their young children before they enter Kindergarten.**

## **Your child will earn Milestone Rewards!**

**Your child will receive a reading log and a sticker when registered to start. For every 100 books a sticker is earned plus they will earn the following rewards:**

- **250 books = a pencil & notebook**
- **500 books = book bag**
- **750 books = a free book**
- **1,000 books = a certificate with their picture taken for the Facebook page and a Kindergarten Ready School supply kit**



## **Register Today!**

- **This program is for babies, toddlers, and preschoolers who have not yet entered Kindergarten.\***  
**\*Your child may still participate if they are in Transitional Kindergarten**
- **Books can be from home, from the library, at the doctor’s office, audio or eBook format.**
- **Yes, you can read a book more than once!**
- **Siblings, grandparents, caregivers, and even library storytellers can all count as “readers”.**
- **Earn rewards when milestones are reached.**
