

# Youth Fishing Derby OFFICIAL RULES



## Parks & Leisure

1. Children must be wearing the Fishing Derby Wristband to participate in the derby.
2. No hooks in the water before 9:00am.
3. Only one hook, on one pole, per child, in the water at one time.
4. Parents may help in the following ways:
  - Baiting the hook.
  - Casting the line.
  - Netting the fish.
5. CHILDREN MUST REEL IN FISH BY THEMSELVES.
6. Any live fish caught will count as part of the stringer.
7. Each fish caught will be immediately weighed at the weigh station and recorded to the child by name, age and wristband number.
8. There is no limit of fish per child.
9. Largest stringers will be determined by total weight.
10. Derby fishing will end at 11:00am.
11. Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd largest stringers in each age group, and one trophy to the overall "Biggest Fish".
12. Age Groups: 2-7 years old and 8-15 years old.
