

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CDBG
2023/24 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

30- Day Public Comment Review Period

April 5, 2024 to May 7, 2024

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A Substantial Amendment to the 2023/2024 AP is being proposed to add an activity for repayment of the Section 108 loan; and to re-allocate \$279,864 in 2023 entitlement funds from the Multi-Sport Fields Improvement Project to the Section 108 loan repayment, as the sale of the Heritage Center has not finalized and the repayment was to be paid with the sale proceeds. The total of funds that need to be reprogrammed is \$279,864.
