- REGULAR MEETING The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM with Mayor Richard Hayward presiding. Rusty Adams was present to lead prayer. Councilmembers present: Ben Cochran, Lyle Sykes & Cameron Johnston.
- MINUTES Councilmember Johnston moved and Cochran seconded to approve the minutes from the November 9th meeting. Motion carried.
- INVOICES Councilmember Cochran moved and Sykes seconded to pay invoices in the amount of \$68,429.38. Motion carried.
- RESOLUTION 297 Resolution allowing Security Benefit 457 deferred compensation plan to be available to city employees.

Councilmember Cochran moved and Sykes seconded to approve 297 the Altamont KPERS 457 plan, City Clerk Heather Beasley asked to amend the motion to Security Benefit 457, Cochran "I'll amend my motion" Sykes seconded the amendment. Motion carried.

LAWN MOWER QUOTE Baugher Equipment quoted a 2024 Grasshopper 900D at \$21,454.20 add an extra \$4,372.75 with an additional 72" deck. The trade in value of the 2013 Grasshopper 725 trade-in value \$4000.00, there would also be the option to sell the mower on Purple Wave Auctions. The regular maintenance on the 2013 Grasshopper mower is estimated to cost \$979.10. If we choose to keep the 2013 Grasshopper, there are additional repair expenses estimated in the amount of \$5171.00 due to the age of the machine to keep it in good working condition making the total upkeep cost estimate is \$6,150.10. Councilmember Cochran wanted to verify again that the money was in the budget for the mower. City Administrator Myers stated that there was plenty of money in the lake fund, not much comes out of that. She stated that the park fund could also be used for that expense as the mower is used to mow the park as well. Councilmember Sykes asked if there was any benefit to keeping the 2013 mower or would it need to be used to offset the cost of the new mower. Superintendent Myers thought that it needed to be used to help offset the cost of the new mower, and get the larger deck to make mowing the lake easier.

Councilmember Cochran moved and Johnston seconded to approve the purchase of the 2024 Grasshopper 900D for \$21,454.20 from Baugher equipment, Cochran "I will amend my motion to include the additional 72" deck for \$4,372.75. Motion carried.

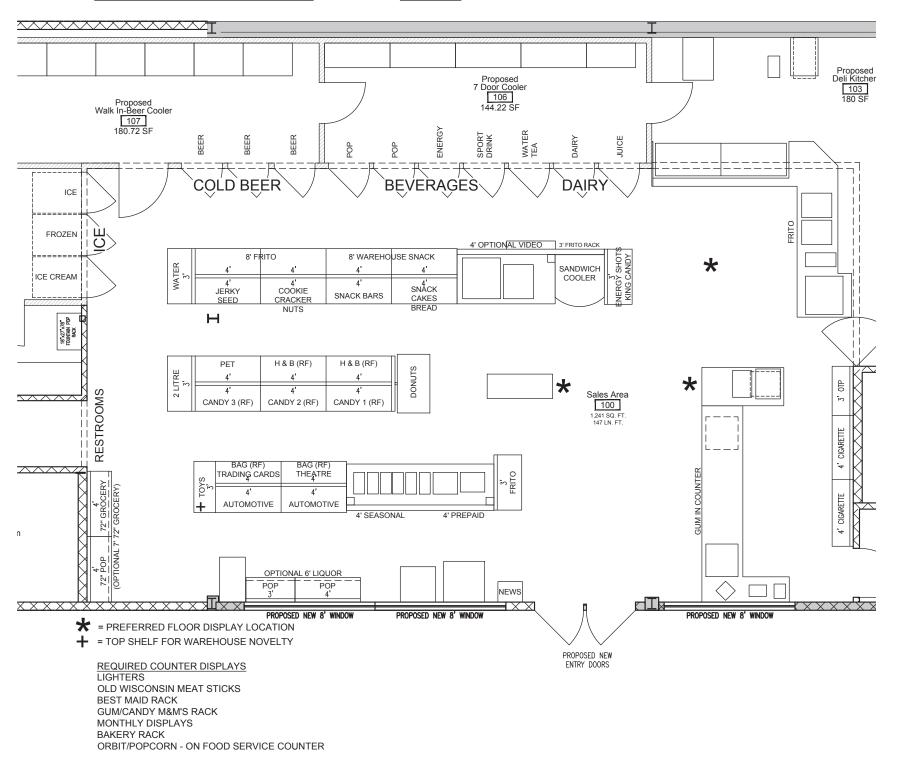

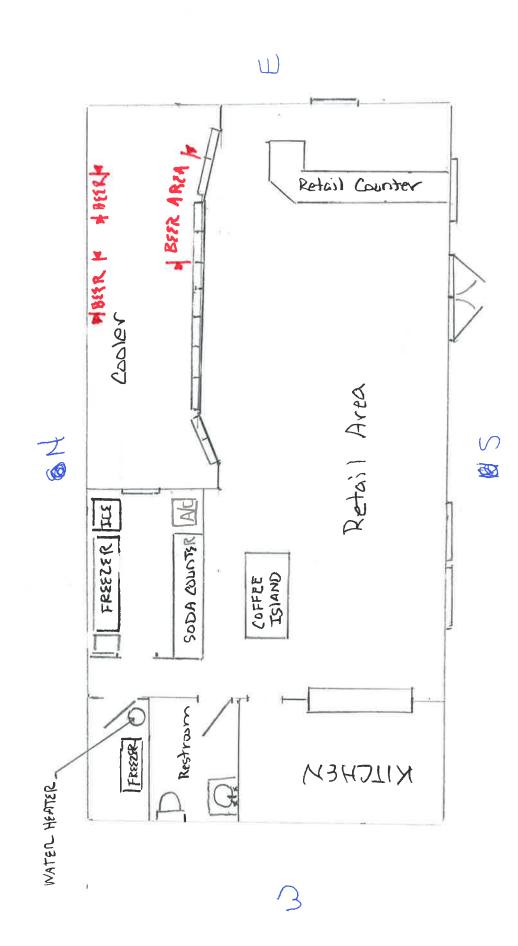

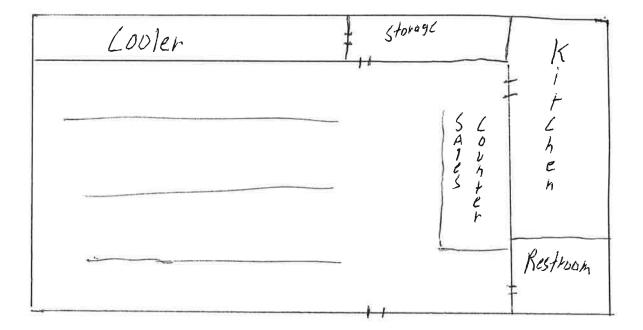

Summary

In-Car camera's and Body Camera's were purchased in October of 2018 from Kustom Signals

Over the last couple years were having issues with the body camera's failing to properly work, issues with them turning on and not able to turn them off, or them just not turning on, numerous issues with battery failures lately.

Issues with the uniform mounts breaking and unable to attach to the uniform or duty vest.

There have been times when we had 3 of the 4 camera's sent off for repairs at the same time.

When these failures happen we lose video footage contained on the camera's that we need for court

In-car Camera's systems have been locking up, 2 of the systems failed and we had to have the tech remote in and reprogram the system, but lost all the features, the system has been glitching in all 3 In-car systems.

Taser's were purchased in December of 2013

The display doesn't show up properly, unable to tell if they carrying a charge or are functioning properly and we don't have enough to outfit each officer at this time.

Chief and LeaAnn,

Thank you both and Sergeant Powell for all your help and collaboration these past few weeks. I greatly appreciate your communication and work on this project. I have attached all 3 proposals built from our conversations. I added the magnetic charging cables on the body camera quote. You will see the cost of \$234 but I removed that cost from another line item to offset the cable cost. Both the Body Cameras and In-Car cameras have our TAP program. As a reminder, I have included a few important benefits of our TAP programs.

- Body Cameras/docking station refreshes at the 30 mo. and 60 mo. marks

-If we release a new body camera, you have the choice of a free upgrade to latest at your refresh marks

As mentioned, these quotes **include a substantial number of discounts and savings**. **Between all 3 quotes, there is a total of about \$7,500 discounts which, with Bundle savings, make a total of \$18,000.** Should we not receive approval and signature before the expiration date of 12/22/23 and this project push into next year, we will lose out on the discounts <u>plus</u> be subject to the price increase that will be coming in 2024. The price increase has not been released yet, so I am not sure to what degree inflation will hit. If the trends are the same as last year, we could expect these quotes to not only go up by the \$7,500 in discounts going away, but also by an additional \$10,000+ (estimated) depending on inflation.

Ultimately, by moving forward this year, we can take advantage of end-of-year discounts, avoid the price increase, and still not pay anything until 2024. Please let me know if you have any questions at all!

Such motion, including the required statement, shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting and shall be maintained as a part of the permanent records of the body or agency. (b) No subjects shall be discussed at any closed or executive meeting, except the following:

(1) Personnel matters of nonelected personnel;

(2) consultation with an attorney for the body or agency which would be deemed privileged in the attorney-client relationship;

(3) matters relating to employer-employee negotiations whether or not in consultation with the representative or representatives of the body or agency;

(4) confidential data relating to financial affairs or trade secrets of corporations, partnerships, trusts, and individual proprietorships;

(5) matters relating to actions adversely or favorably affecting a person as a student, patient or resident of a public institution, except that any such person shall have the right to a public hearing if requested by the person;

(6) preliminary discussions relating to the acquisition of real property;
