

STATEMENT OF COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
May 9, 2022

The City Council of the City of Anamosa met in Regular Session May 9, 2022, at the Anamosa Library and Learning Center and via Zoom at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Rod Smith presiding. The following Council Members were present: Rich Crump, Jeff Stout, Kay Smith, Teresa Tuetken, Alan Zumbach and Brooke Gombert. Absent: None.
