STATEMENT OF COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS August 23, 2021

The City Council of the City of Anamosa met in Regular Session August 23, 2021 at the Anamosa Library and Learning Center and via Zoom at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Rod Smith presiding. The following Council Members were present: John Machart, Rich Crump, Jeff Stout, Kay Smith, Alan Zumbach, and Galen Capron. Absent: none. Also present were Beth Brincks, City Administrator/Clerk; Rebecca Vernon, Library Director and Jeremiah Hoyt, Police Chief. Iowa Code Chapter 21, as interpreted, permits public meetings to be held electronically.

Mayor Rod Smith called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Roll call was taken with a quorum present.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Crump, second by Zumbach to approve the agenda. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Motion by Stout, second by Capron to approve the minutes of the August 9, 2021 Regular City Council meeting. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried.

The Mayor opened the public hearing on proposed plans, specs and cost estimate for the Well #6 Project Bid Package No. 1: Well Drilling at 6:01pm.

Crump inquired to whether any comments had been received. There were no submitted written or verbal comments, and with no further public comments or questions.

Motion by Zumbach to close the public hearing, second by Crump. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried. Hearing closed at 6:02 p.m.

Motion by Smith, second by Crump to approve Resolution 2021-51 accepting the plans and specifications, accepting bid and awarding contract to Gingerich Well & Pump Service, LLC for the Well #6 Bid Package No. 1: Well Drilling. Roll vote. Ayes: Crump, Capron, Stout, Smith, Machart, and Zumbach. Nays: none. Motion carried.

The Mayor opened the public hearing on proposed plans, specs and cost estimate for the Well #6 Project Bid Package No. 2: Well Equipment And Pipeline at 6:03pm.

Motion by Stout, second by Crump to approve Resolution 2021-52 accepting the plans and specifications, accepting bid and awarding contract to Boomerang Corp. for the Well #6 Bid Package No. 2: Well Equipment And Pipeline. Roll vote. Ayes: Crump, Smith, Machart, Zumbach, Stout and Capron. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Motion by Crump, second by Smith to approve the professional services agreement amendment with HR Green for Well #6 construction phase. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Andrew Marsh from HR Green gave a project status update.

Derek Lumsden from Jones County Economic Development gave an update on the Downtown Façade Project and presented Change Order No. 8 for approval. The Change Order is actually a reduction in cost. He stated that currently the construction is facing some supply chain issues. He has received good feedback on the renderings. Motion by Smith, second by Crump to approve Change Order No. 8. Derek next gave an overview of the county wide Childcare feasibility study. Strategies for creating and retaining quality child care options were presented.

Lindsay Beaman of Snyder and Associates presented their monthly project status update. The public information meeting for the Highway 151 Grade Separation went well.

Motion by Crump, second by Machart to approve the appointment of new Park Board Members Bruce Miell, Mindy Brown, and Hailee Adam as recommended by the Anamosa Park Board. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Motion by Stout, second by Capron to approve a new Tobacco Permit for Main Street Tobacco. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Motion by Zumbach, second by Smith to approve current bills. Ayes: all. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Beth Brincks, City Administrator/City Clerk presented her City Administrator's report.

Mayor and Council Reports: Smith gave a reminder about the Library Levy Petition. Stout reported that the pool has closed for the season, co-ed slow pitch league was starting as well as youth flag football.

WHEREAS: Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week,





SECTION 00520 AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is dated as of the _____ day of _____, 2021, by and between the <u>City of Anamosa</u> (hereafter called Owner) and <u>Gingerich Well & Pump Service</u>, LLC (hereafter called Contractor).

Owner and Contractor, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. WORK.

Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated under the Contract Documents entitled Jordan Well No. 6, Bid Package 1: Well Drilling generally described as follows:

Furnish all labor, materials, and equipment needed for the drilling and construction of one Cambrian-Ordovician well into the Jordan Sandstone aquifer. Depth of the well bottom shall be 1,640-feet.

ARTICLE 2. CONTRACT TIMES.

Work under the proposed Contract Documents shall be commenced upon written Notice to Proceed to be issued on or before <u>September 14, 2021</u>. Tree clearing shall commence no sooner than October 1, 2021 and be completed by a Milestone Date of <u>October 29, 2021</u>. The project shall be substantially completed and ready for operation on or before <u>June 24, 2022</u>, and shall be fully complete on or before <u>August 26, 2022</u>, subject to any extension of time, which may be granted by the Owner.

ARTICLE 3. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES.

Owner and the contractor recognize that time is of the essence of this Agreement and that the Owner will suffer financial loss if the Work is not completed within the time specified in Article 2 herein, plus any extensions thereof allowed in accordance with Article 15 of the General Conditions. They also recognize the delays, expense, and difficulties involved in proving in a legal proceeding the actual loss suffered by the Owner if the Work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, the Owner and the Contractor agree that as liquidated damages for delay (but not as a penalty) the Contractor shall pay the Owner \$250 for each day that expires after the Milestone Date, \$750 for each day that expires after Substantial Completion, and \$500 for each day that expires after Final Completion. Liquidated Damages for the Milestone, Substantial, and Final Completion Dates shall not be additive.

ARTICLE 4. CONTRACT PRICE.

Owner shall pay Contractor for completion of the Work pursuant to the Contractor's Bid Form and in accordance with the Contract Documents in current funds as follows: <u>One Million Four</u> Hundred Forty Two Thousand Seven Hundred and No/100 dollars, (\$1,442,700.00)

ARTICLE 5. PAYMENT PROCEDURES.

Contractor shall submit Applications for Payment in accordance with Article 15 of the General Conditions. Applications for Payment will be processed by Engineer as provided in the General Conditions.

ARTICLE 6. ASSIGNMENT.

No assignment by a party hereto of any rights under or interests in the Contract Documents will be binding on another party hereto without the written consent of the party sought to be bound; and specifically but without limitation monies that may become due and monies that are due may not be assigned without such consent (except to the extent that the effect of this restriction may be limited by law), and unless specifically stated to the contrary in any written consent to an assignment, no assignment will release or discharge the assignor from any duty or responsibility under the Contract Documents.

Owner and contractor each binds itself, its partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives to the other party hereto, its partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives in respect of all covenants, agreements and obligations contained in the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 7. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

The Contract Documents, which comprise the entire contract between Owner and Contractor concerning the Work, consist of this Agreement; Performance and Maintenance Bond and Payment Bond; Notice to Proceed; General Conditions; Supplementary General Conditions; and Drawings and Technical Specifications, Contractor's Bid Form, and all written amendments and other documents amending, modifying or supplementing the Contract Documents pursuant to paragraph 3.04 of the General Conditions, which may be fully executed after the effective date of the Agreement, for the said project.

ARTICLE 8. ENGINEER'S ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND ATTORNEY'S FEES

The Contractor shall reimburse the Owner for any Engineer's additional services or attorney's fees made necessary by the Contractor's failure to Finally Complete the Work within the time specified in Article 2 herein or within sixty (60) days after the date specified in in Article 2 herein for Project Substantial Completion, whichever occurs first.

ARTICLE 9. ATTORNEY'S FEES

In the event the Owner should prevail in any legal action arising out of the performance or nonperformance of this Agreement, the Contractor shall pay, in addition to any damages, all expenses of such action including reasonable attorney's fees, all expert witness fees, costs, and

litigation expenses incurred by the Owner, including those incurred on appeal. The term "legal action" shall be deemed to include any arbitration, administrative proceedings, and all actions at law or in equity, including appeals.

THIS AGREEMENT is dated as of the _____ day of _____, 2021, by and between the <u>City of Anamosa</u> (hereafter called Owner) and <u>Boomerang Corp.</u> (hereafter called Contractor).

Owner and Contractor, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. WORK.

Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated under the Contract Documents entitled <u>Jordan Well No. 6, Bid Package 2: Well Equipment and Pipeline</u> generally described as follows:

Furnish all labor, materials, and equipment needed for the construction of a new Well House to house the discharge meter and valves for Well No. 6, as well as associated electrical and mechanical equipment. Bid Package No. 2 also includes the installation of submersible well pump equipment in the City of Anamosa's new Jordan Well No. 6, as well as construction of a new PCC access drive, generator and pad, associated site work, and approximately 700 feet of 8" PVC raw water main to supply the existing Water Treatment Plant.

ARTICLE 2. CONTRACT TIMES.

Work under the proposed Contract Documents shall be commenced upon written Notice to Proceed to be issued on or before <u>September 4, 2021</u>. The project shall be substantially completed and ready for operation on or before <u>August 5, 2022</u>, and shall be and shall be fully complete on or before <u>October 7, 2022</u>, subject to any extension of time, which may be granted by the Owner.

ARTICLE 3. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES.

Owner and the contractor recognize that time is of the essence of this Agreement and that the Owner will suffer financial loss if the Work is not completed within the time specified in Article 2 herein, plus any extensions thereof allowed in accordance with Article 15 of the General Conditions.
