CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:

Alan Johnson, City Administrator reviewed the research results regarding adding auto-dialers/alarms to the lift stations. Dan Smith stated that it will cost \$600 per lift station. Alan stated that all five lift stations will be updated. He also stated that the City will need a list of customers to notify for each lift station and they will need to decide what form of notification will work the best. More discussion followed. Alan stated that the updates should be installed in the next month.

Public with Business not on the Agenda

Darrel Rawson addressed the Council asking when the residents on Holt Street will be required to remove their high pressure pumps. Alan Johnson, City Administrator explained that the project should be done in the next two weeks, then the system will need to be tested. The property owners will be notified after the testing is complete to remove their high pressure pumps.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL:

Bill Feldmann – E911/EMA, stated that the 911 Board is working with the city of Martelle to place equipment on their new water tower. Then they will be looking at replacing the equipment on the Amber tower. The board is working on a system creating redundancy.

Mike Dearborn – P&R Board, stated that they did receive an \$8,000 grant and they are working on raising the other \$2,000 to update the playground equipment. He stated that the Thanksgiving meal at the LCC went well and they served 130 people and prepared and delivered 57 carry-out meals. They will be having a small scale open house on February 4th to celebrate 25 years for the LCC.

Brady Reynolds stated that he and Bill Feldmann had attended the Library open house last Sunday and he was very impressed with all the Library has to offer.
