

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-08

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Anamosa has considered the proposed fiscal year 2021 maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a public notice of said public hearing is required to be published in the designated local paper no less than ten (10) and no more than twenty (20) days prior to the public hearing, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed maximum property tax dollars was held on Monday, February 24, 2020,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANAMOSA, IOWA, that the maximum property tax levy for the affected tax levies, not including voted general fund levies, debt service levy, or capital improvement reserve levy, for fiscal year 2021 shall not exceed \$14.0195 per one thousand dollars in valuation or \$1,946,453.87 in property tax dollars. The maximum property tax dollars requested for fiscal year 2021 represents a 5.59% increase over the 2020 fiscal year and therefore requires a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council for approval.

Councilmember Crump introduced the foregoing **Resolution No. 2020--08** and moved for its adoption. Councilmember Stout seconded the motion to adopt. The roll was called and the following indicates the result of the vote.
