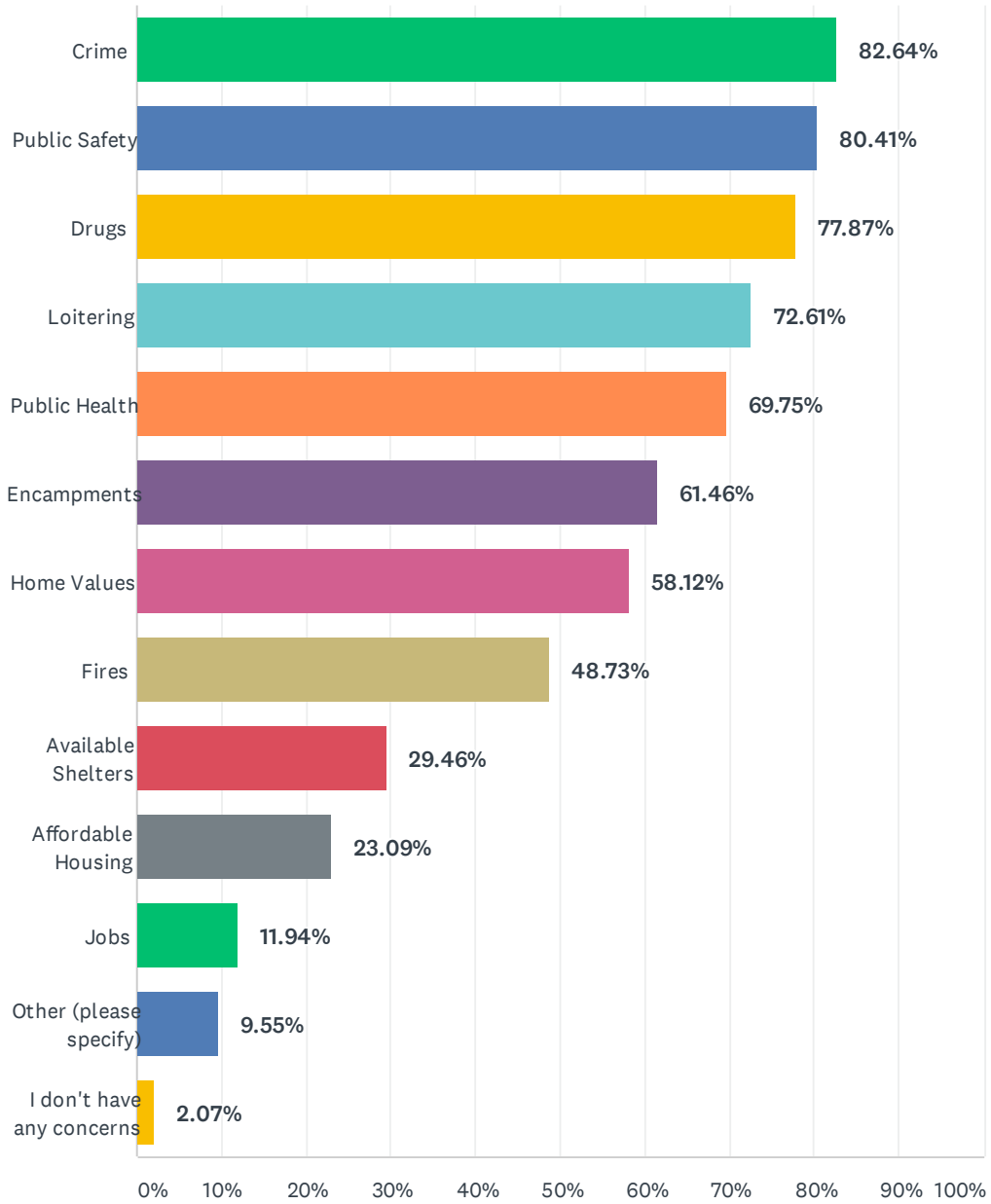


# Q1 What are your concerns about homelessness in Arcadia? (select all that apply)

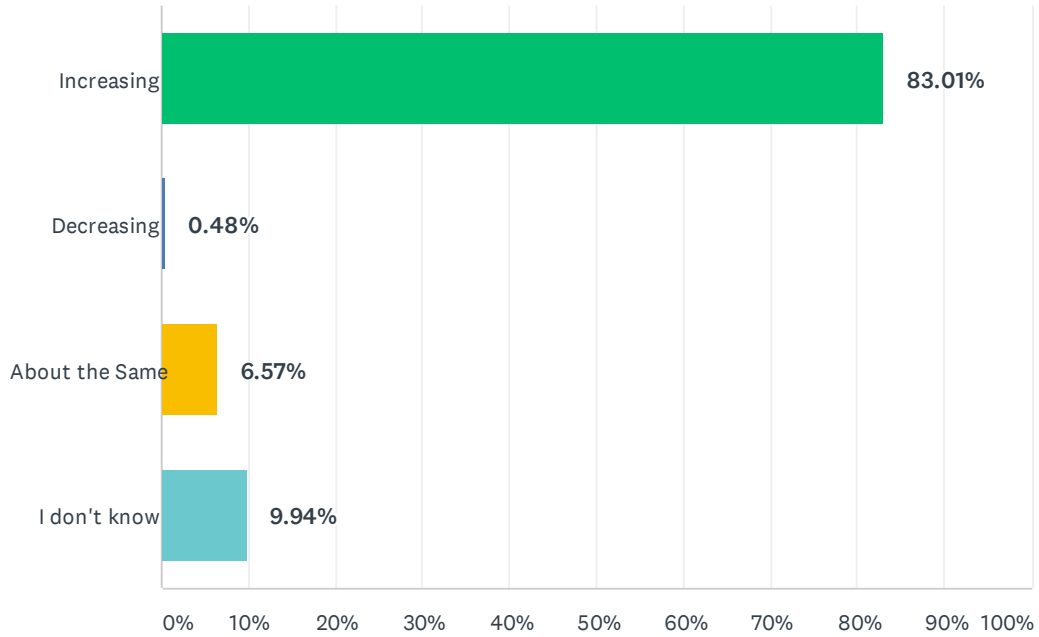

## Q5 Homelessness in Arcadia is...

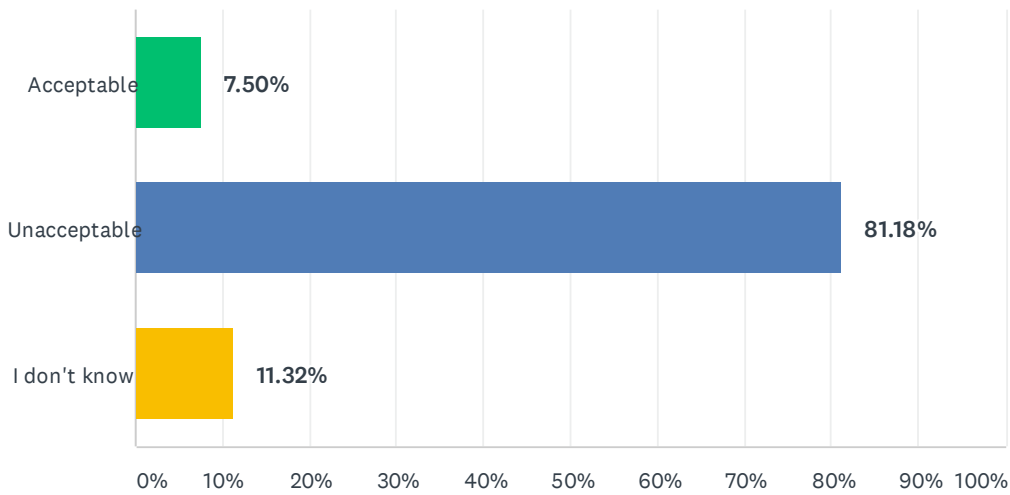

## Q6 The level of homelessness I see in Arcadia is...

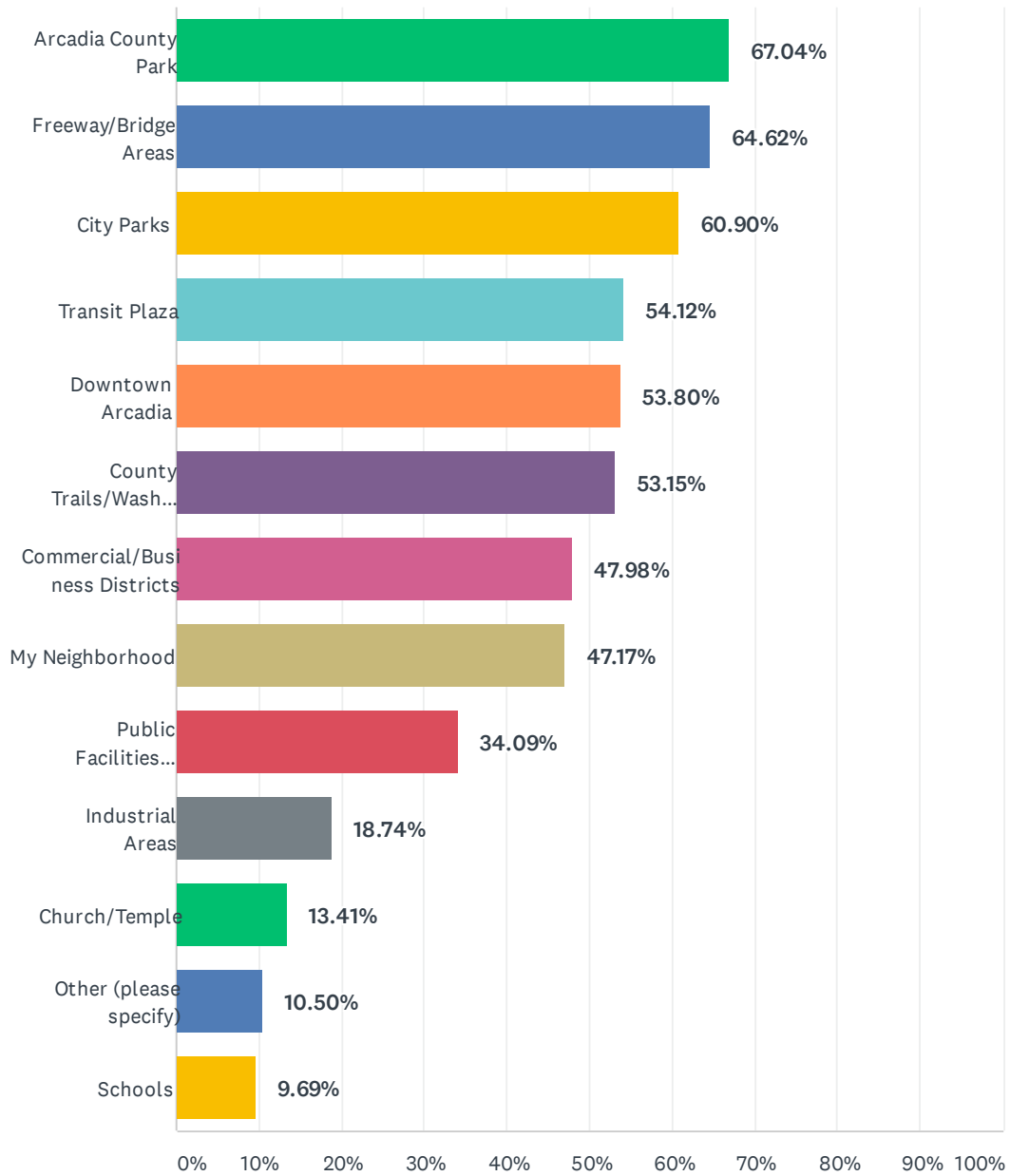

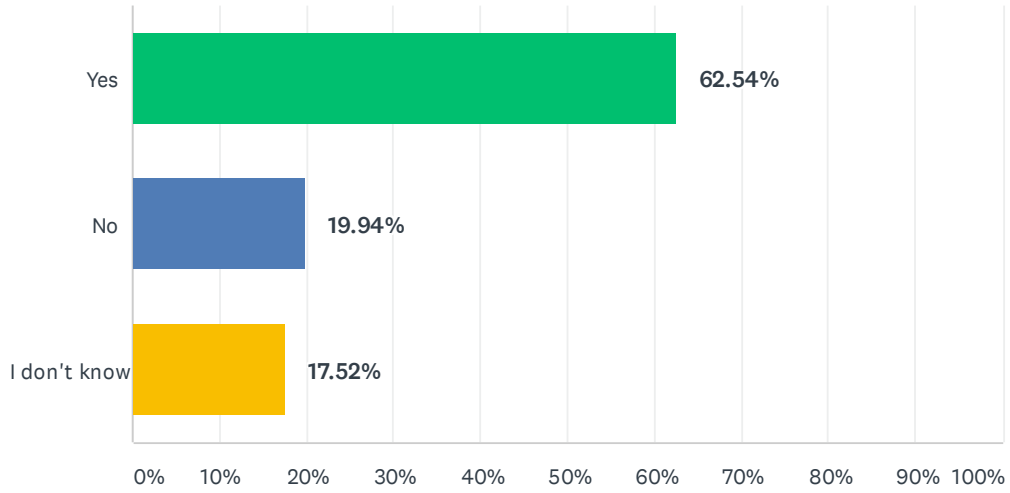

## Q8 Should the City conduct its own Point-in-Time count to learn more about the people experiencing homelessness in Arcadia?

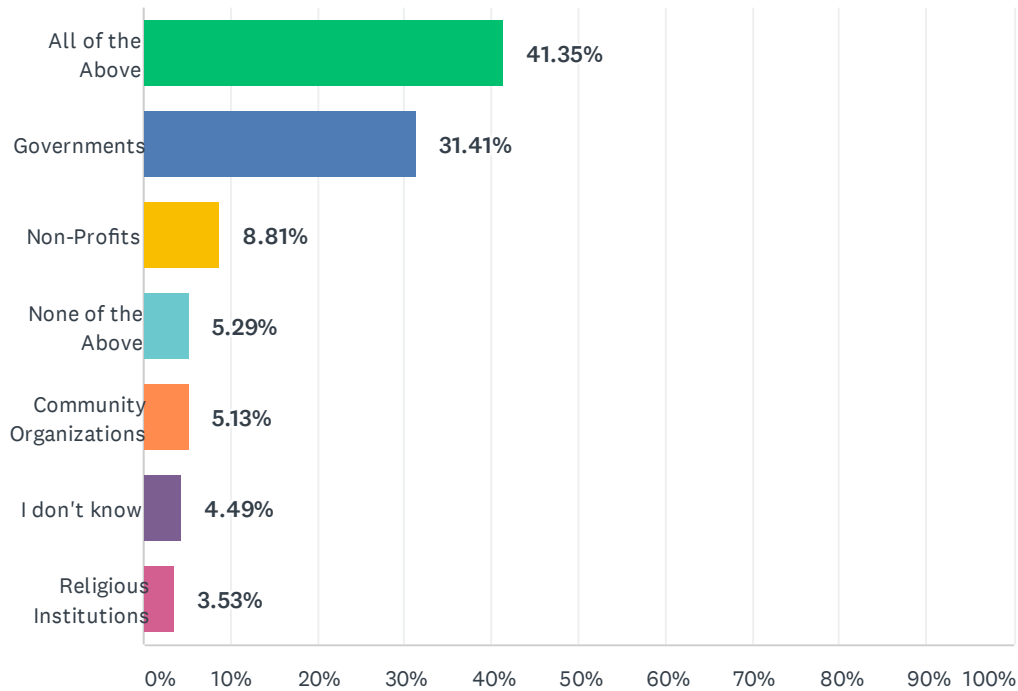

## Q9 Which entities are best suited to help address homelessness?

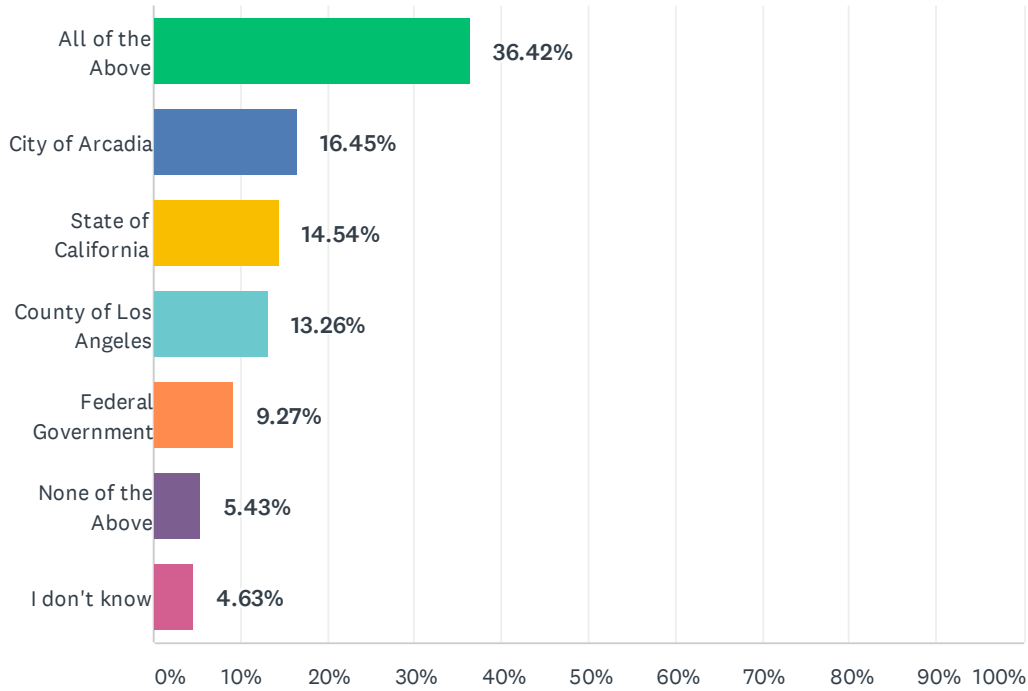

## Q10 Which level of government is best to help solve homelessness in Arcadia?

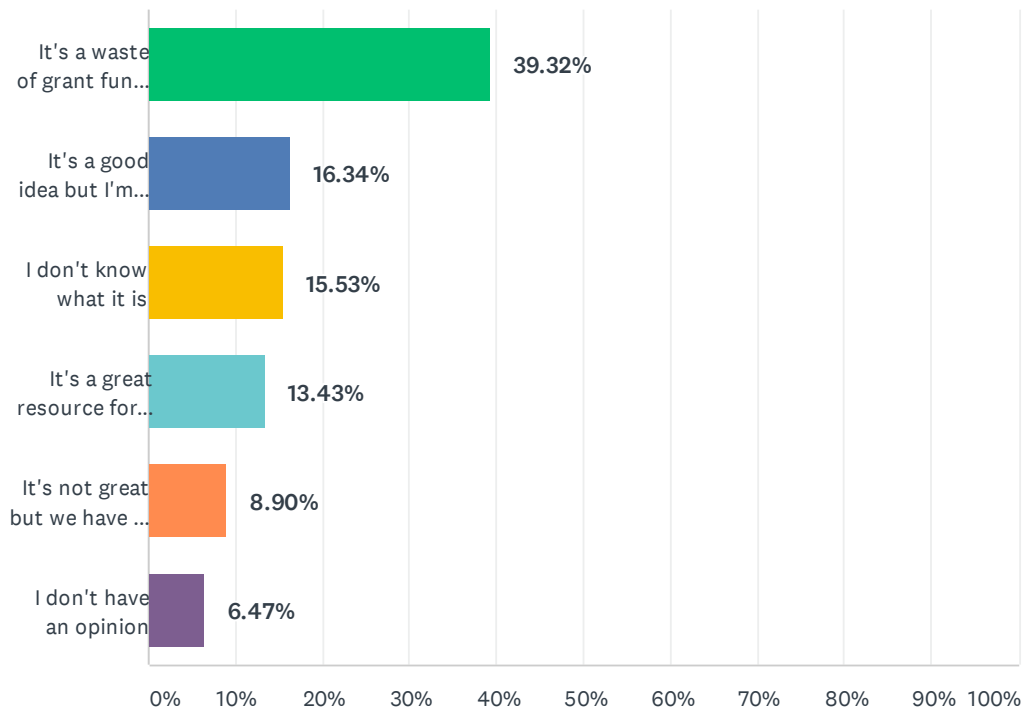

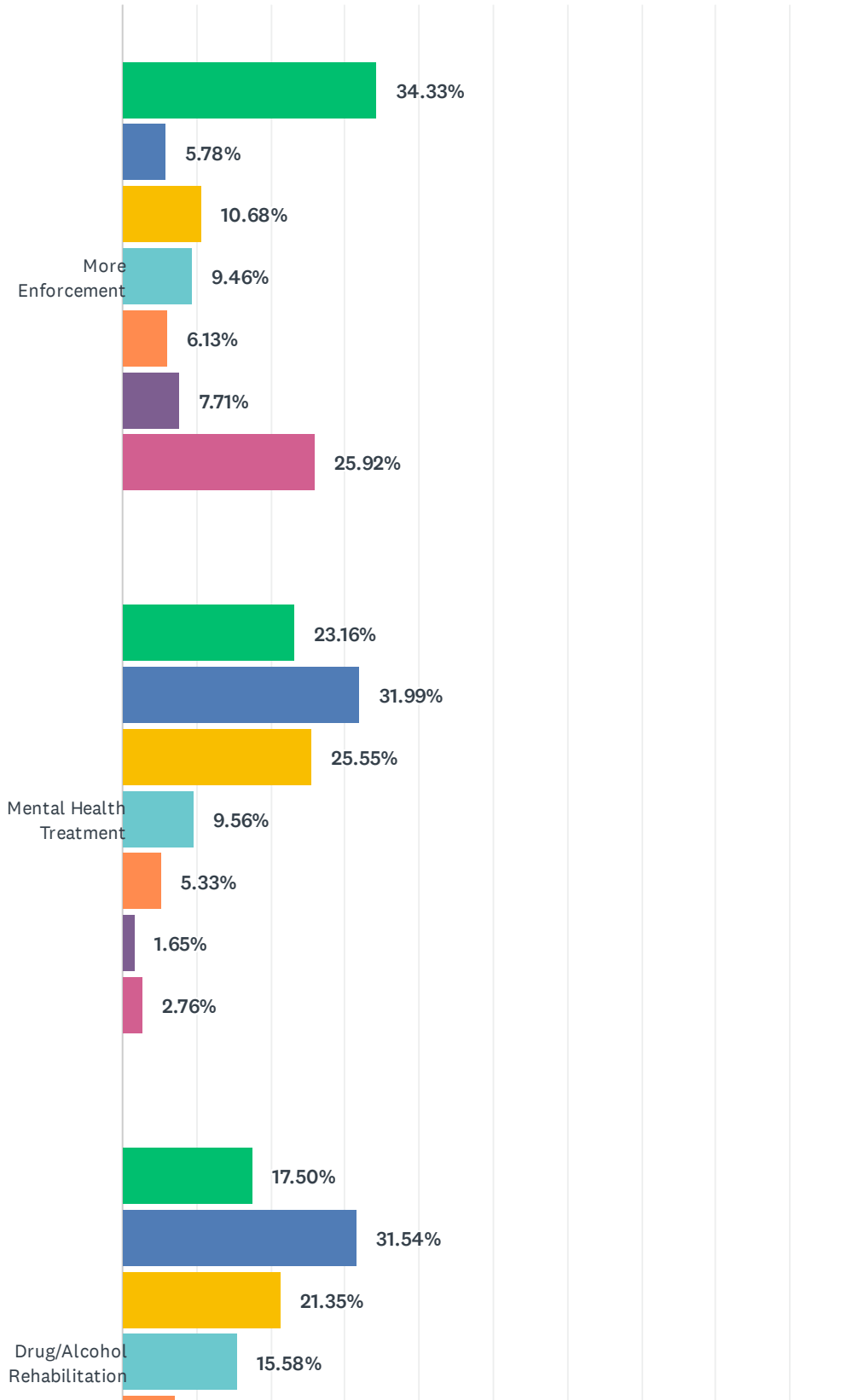

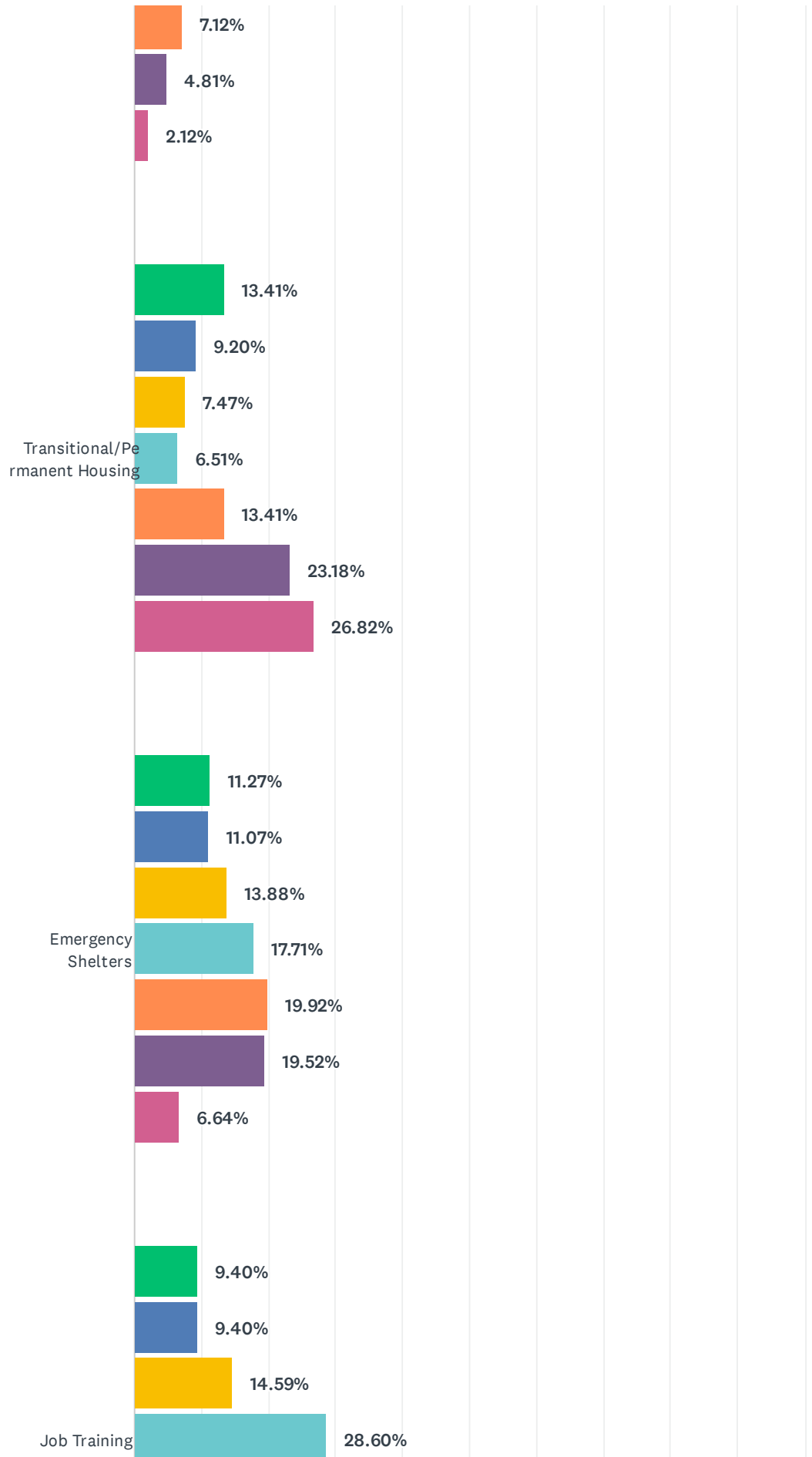

### Q13 Please rank which services you believe will help solve homelessness in Arcadia (1 = most helpful, 7 = least helpful).

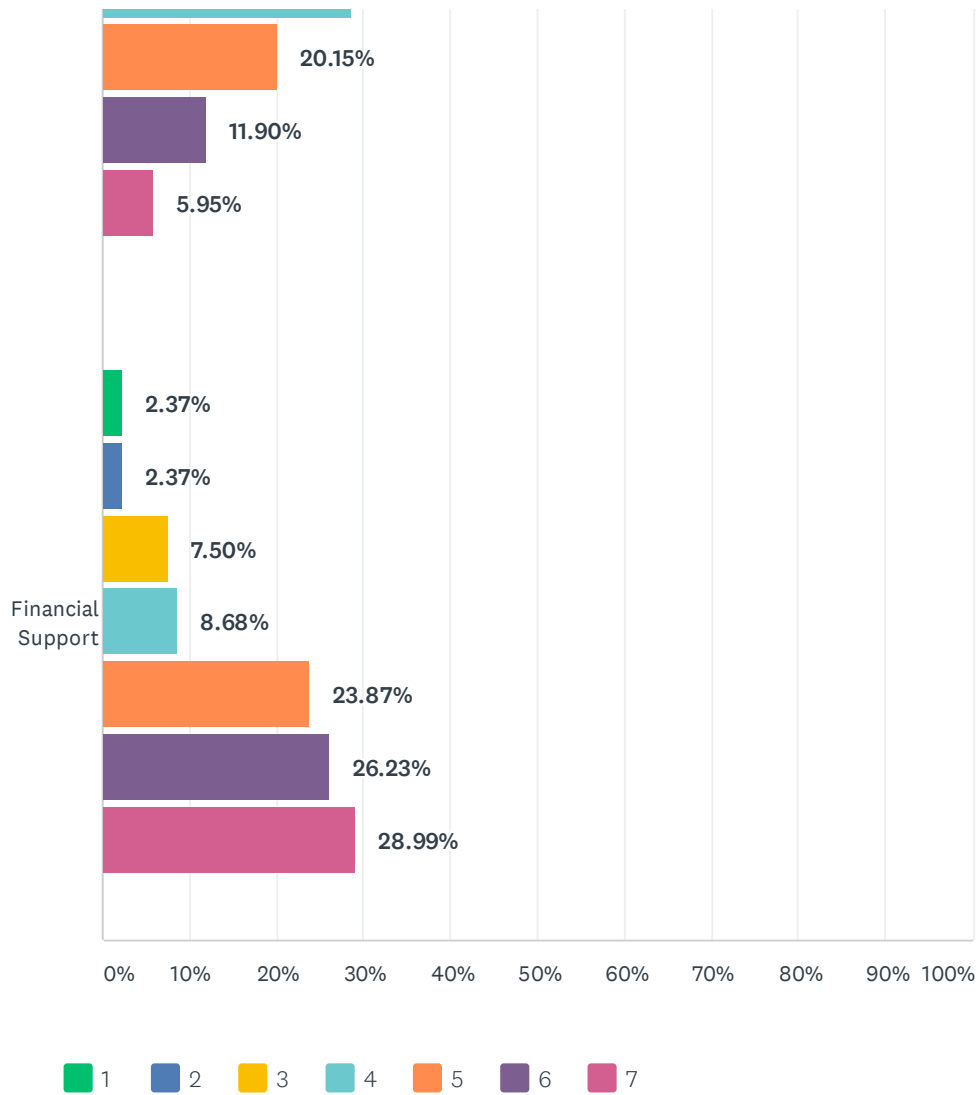

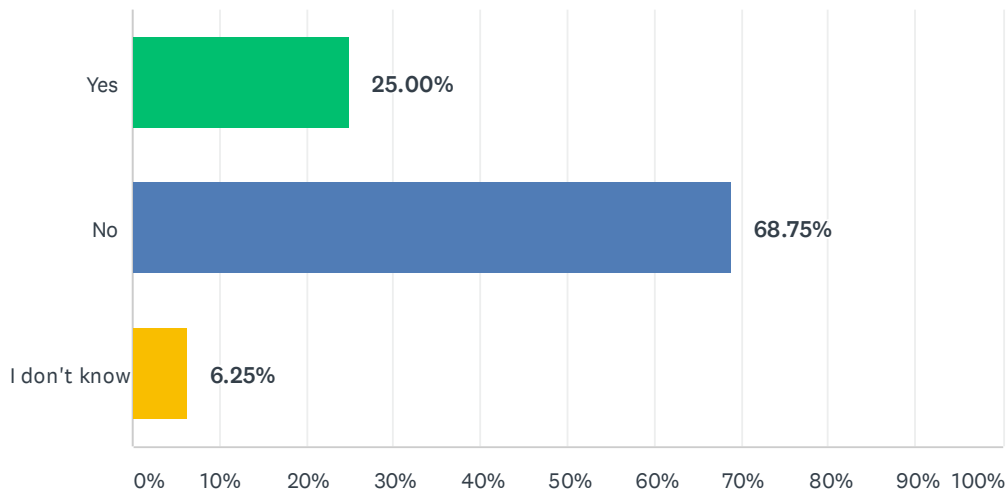

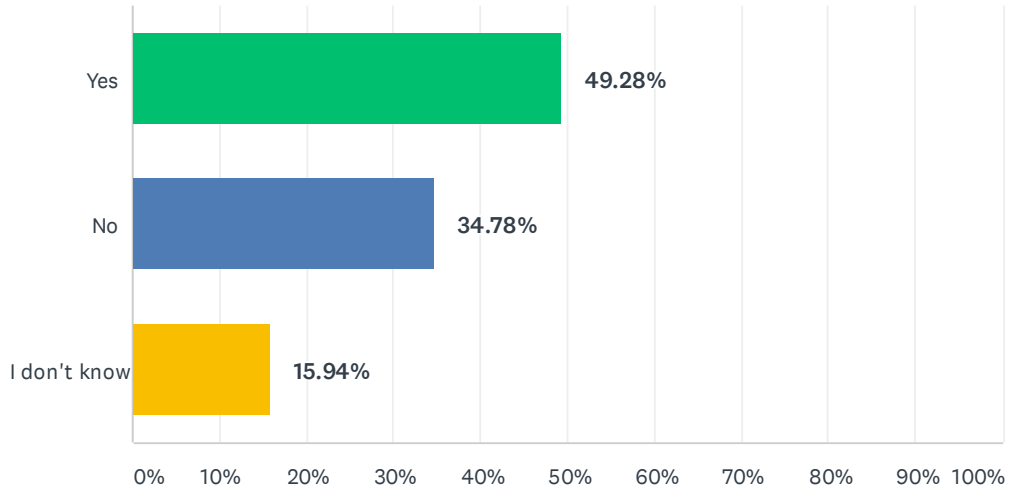

## Q16 Are you aware of the City's Anti-Camping Ordinance?

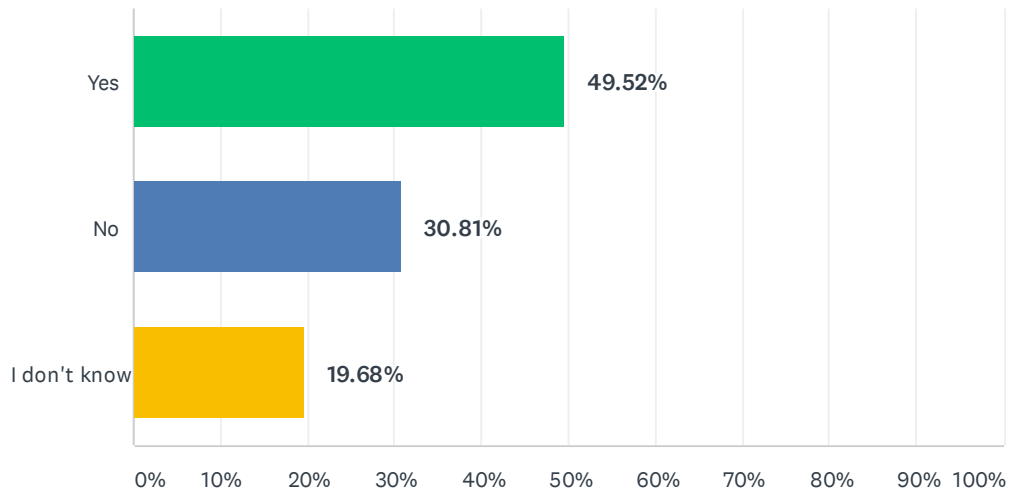

## Q17 Did you know that it is legal to camp on public property if no shelter is available?

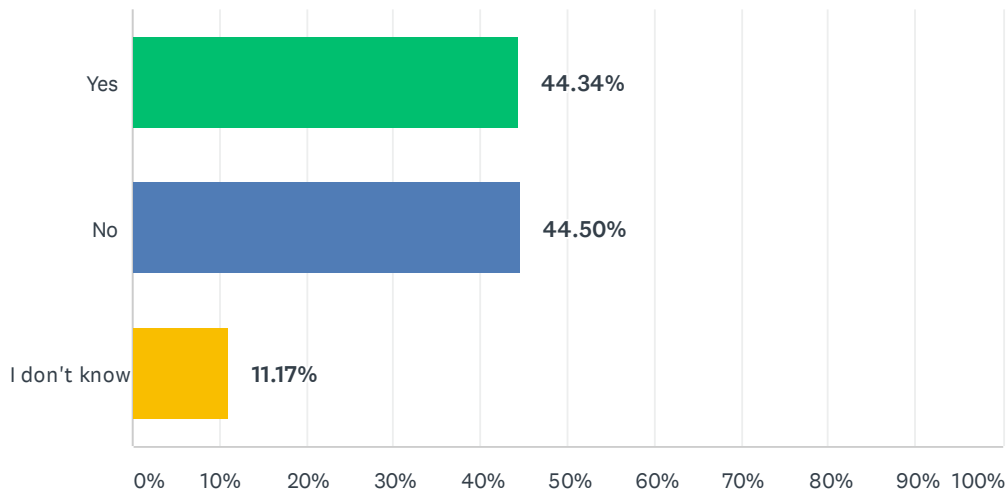

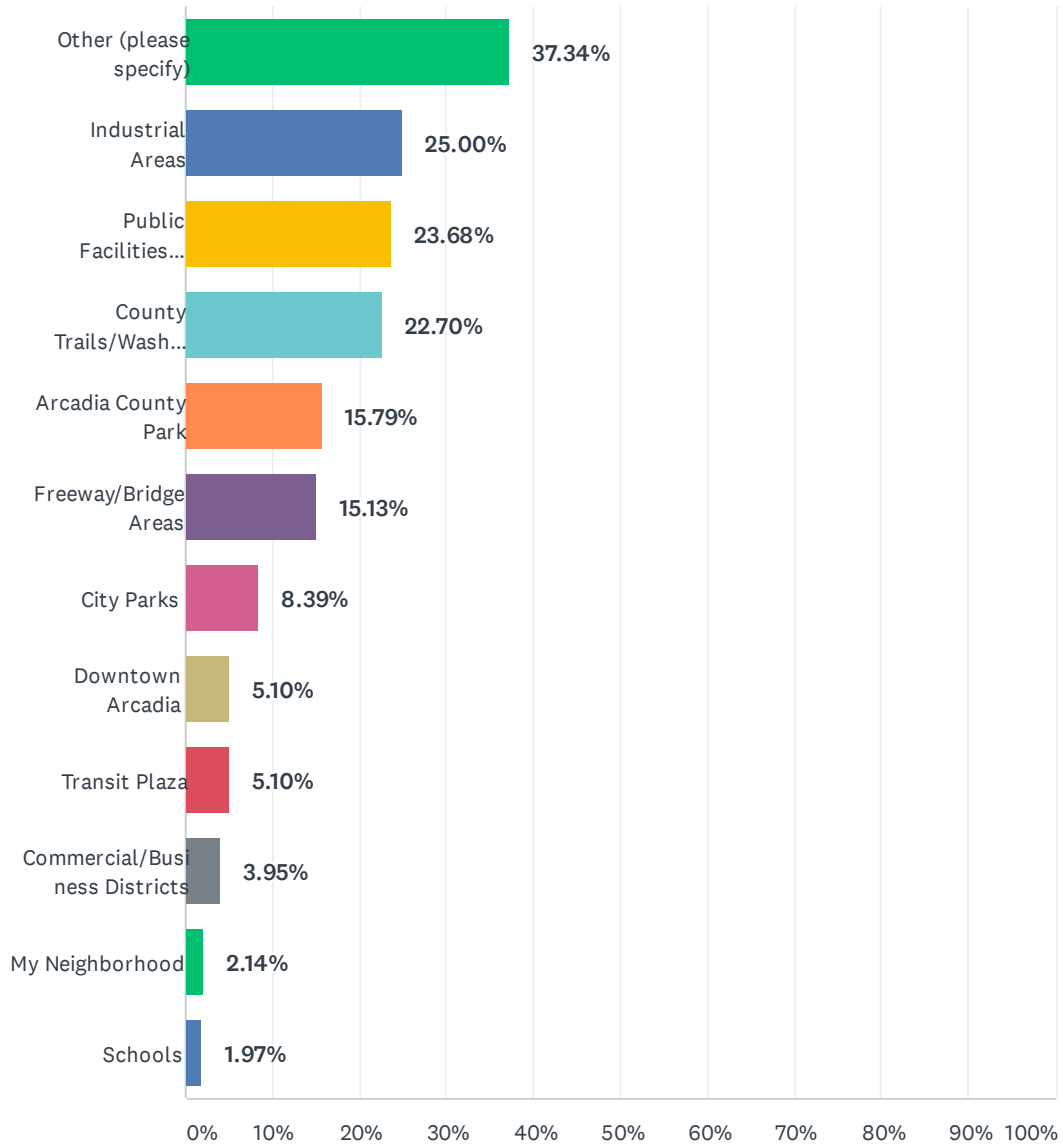

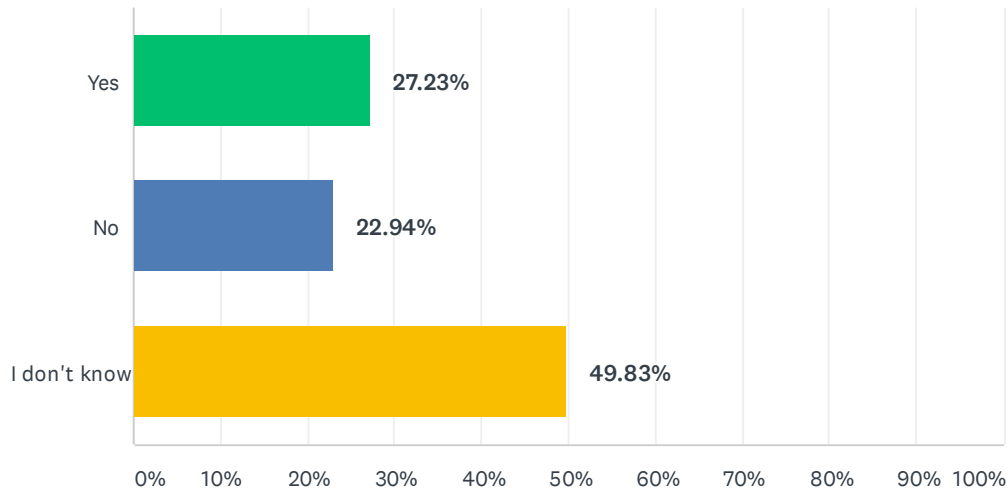

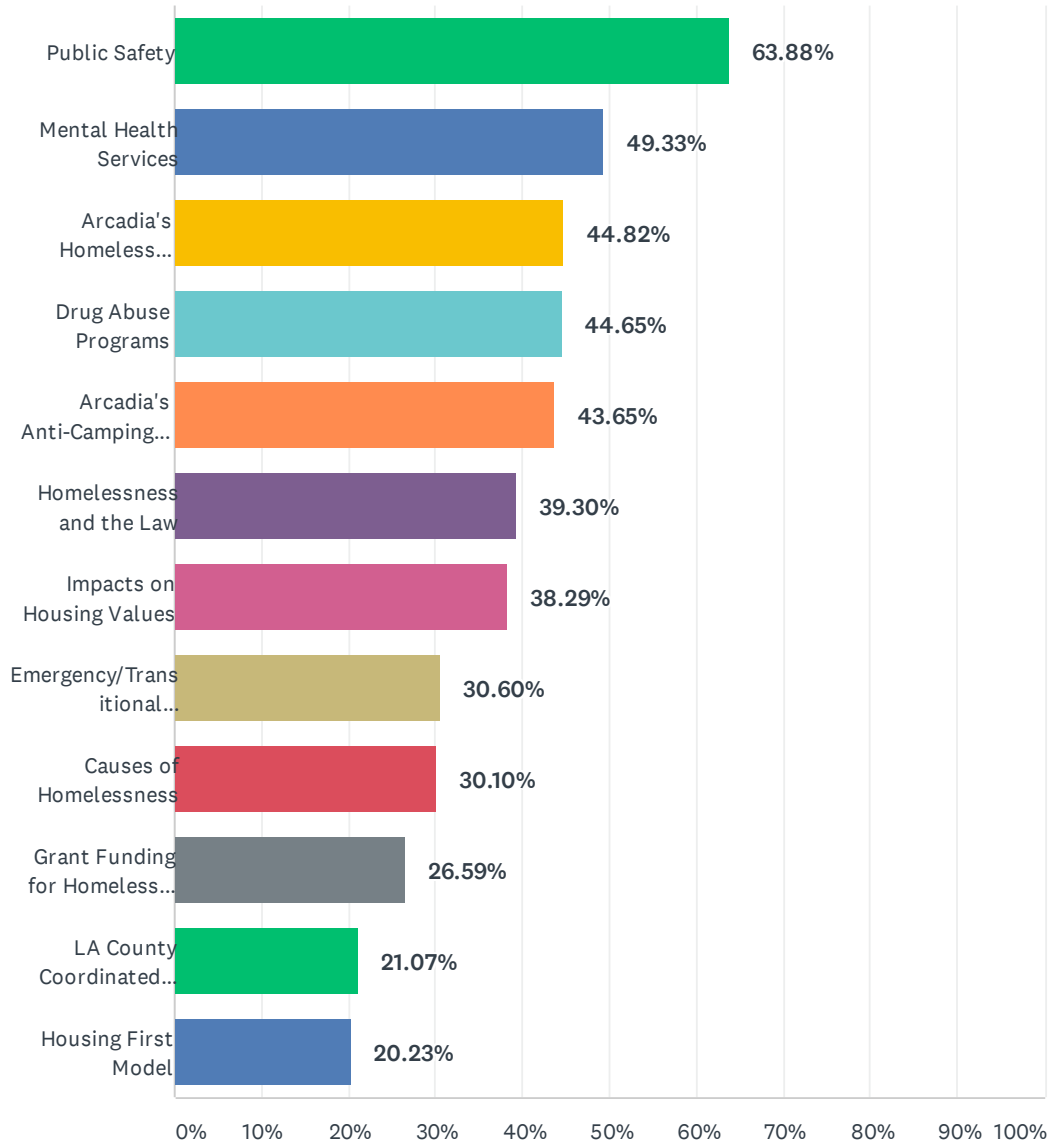

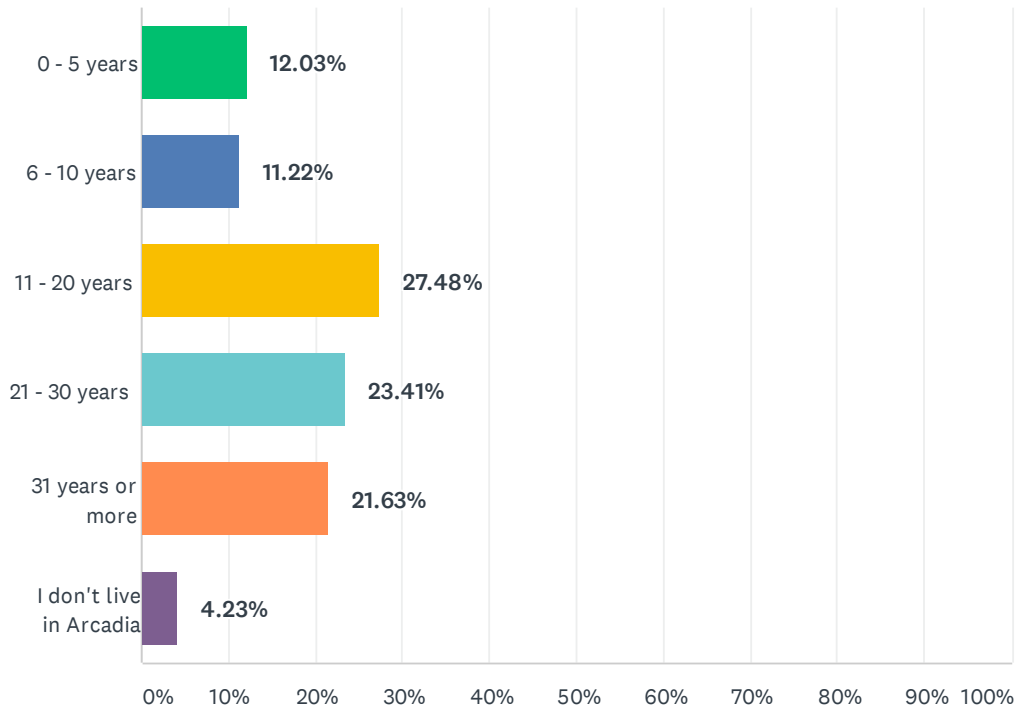

## Q26 Which City Council district do you live in?

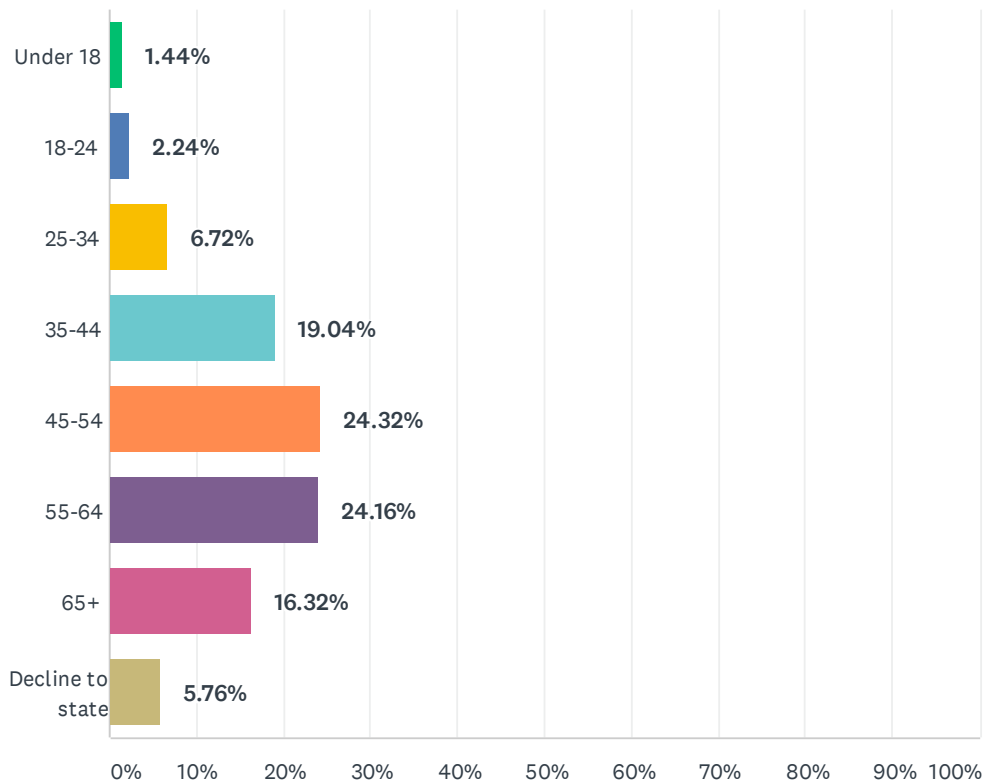

## Q27 What is your age?

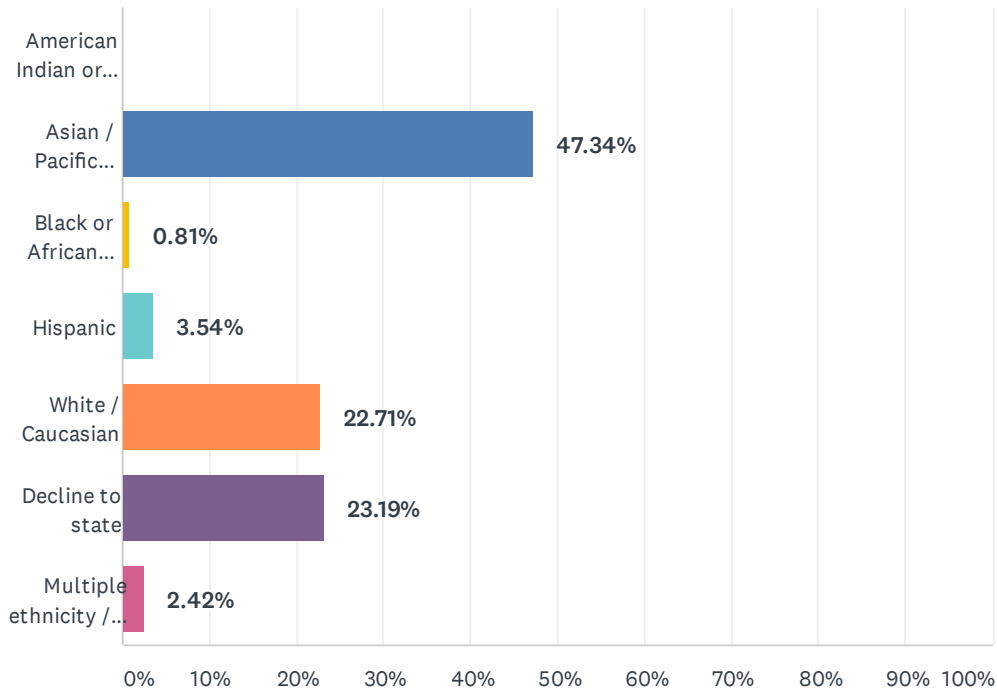

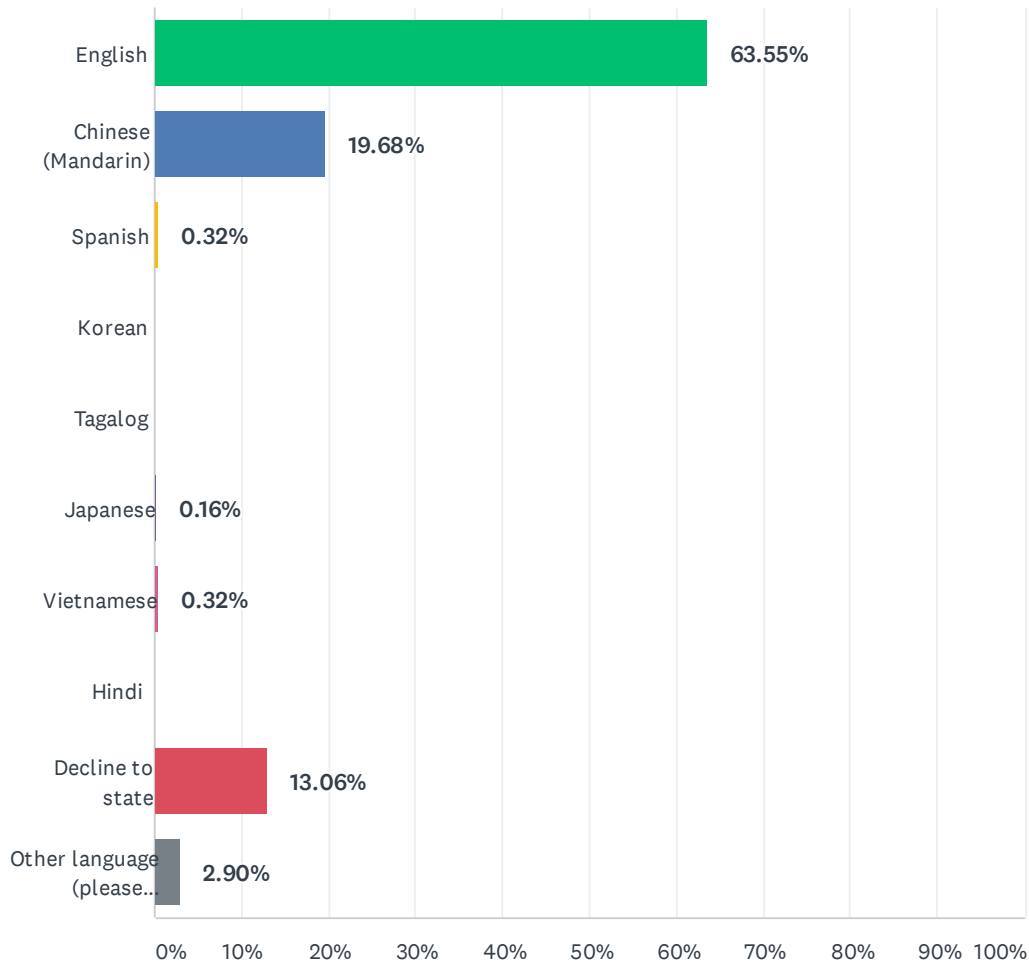
