CONSENT AGENDA

Mayor Buttram advised that the following items were discussed during the recent work session and are presented as a part of the Consent Agenda. The recording clerk read the items into the record:

- a.) Approve City of Athens Budget Amendment No. 1 for Fiscal Year 2013-2014;
- b.) Accept low bid (Bid No. 1595 dated October 25, 2013 as submitted by Stansell Electric Industries for Congress Parkway at Heil Signal Installation;
- c.) Approve Resolution No. 2013-38 to apply for and accept funding for a grant from the Multimodal Access Fund for sidewalks and other multimodal services.

Mayor Buttram asked Shawn Lindsey, Public Works Director, to give a presentation on the proposed multimodal grant project the Council was considering. Mr. Lindsey explained TDOT's Multimodal Access Fund is a new state-funded program created to support the transportation needs of transit users, pedestrians and bicyclists through infrastructure projects that address existing gaps along state routes. Referring to a map of the sidewalks throughout the City, he explained where the new sidewalks would be installed to meet the needs of the community. **On motion by Council Member Perkinson, seconded by Vice Mayor Davis, the Consent Agenda as stated above was approved by the following roll call vote:**
