ATHENS, TENNESSEE – January 4, 2021 – The City of Athens Public Works Department announces the following holiday closure:

The Athens Municipal Building, Public Works, Recycle Center, and Animal Shelter will be closed on Monday, January 18, 2021 in observance of **Martin Luther King Day**. The Municipal Building, Public Works, Recycle Center, and the Animal Shelter will re-open Tuesday, January 19, 2021 during regular business hours.

Residential garbage routes for Monday, January 18, 2021 will be picked up on Tuesday, January 19, 2021. All other residential garbage routes will be on regular schedule. **Please have garbage totes to the road by 7:00 a.m.** Commercial/Industrial garbage routes will be picked up on a limited basis.
