ATHENS, TENNESSEE – January 19, 2022 – The City of Athens Department of Parks and Recreation has announced the Daddy Daughter Dance, originally scheduled for February 11 and 12, 2022, has been rescheduled. The new dance date will be Friday, March 25, and Saturday, March 26, 2022. Dances will be held on Friday at 7:30 pm, and Saturday at 1 pm, 4 pm, and 7:30 pm. Ticket information will be announced on February 23, 2022.

“Our goal is to have a dance with as close to 100% capacity as possible. With the data we have in hand, it was determined that the March dates give us a better chance to do that,” said Austin Fesmire, Director of Parks and Recreation. “We realize the dance is an important part of the life and culture of our community and I want to assure everyone that we are doing everything possible to make that happen, including having a backup set of dates. Thank you for your continued encouragement and for understanding the necessity of this date change,” said Fesmire.
