Easter Egg Hunt

ATHENS, TENNESSEE – April 1, 2022 – The City of Athens Parks and Recreation Department has announced the Athens Easter Egg Hunt, for ages 12 and under, will be Saturday, April 9 at 4:00pm at the Athens Regional Park. There will be over 12,000 eggs with 3 flat screen televisions to be given as grand prizes. In addition to the grand prizes, the Parks and Recreation Department and Athens Area Youth Council will be stuffing and hiding eggs filled with other prizes and local business coupons. Eggs will be in the front of the park, behind the red brick house continuing across the front of the park to the field beside the pavilion. All ages hunt together, and everyone must begin the hunt from the concrete walkways. The hunt will start promptly at 4pm, and due to increased traffic for the event, the department advises participants to arrive 30 minutes early and to bring their own baskets or bags for hunting.

Our Athens Area Youth Council has worked hard on getting great prizes to fill the eggs from local businesses and prize baskets for the kids to hunt.
