ANN STEIN, was first hired on July 2, 1979 and oversaw the Assisted Housing Department. Her first retirement was in 2008.


Ann missed the HABC so much she returned September 8, 2009, as a part-time Assisted Housing Specialist until her recent retirement on May 31, 2020.
