The Authority reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time. However, if the contract is terminated after September 1st of any year, the Authority will be responsible for the full year payment. Training Sessions via webinar for staff and vendors will be provided at no additional cost to the Authority.

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that sufficient funds are available in the budget to cover these services on a yearly basis which shall be encumbered from the operating budget at such time as the services are rendered, as allowed under N.J.A.C. 5:30-5 (b)-2.
