WHEREAS, five bids were received and carefully reviewed and evaluated, and the bid submitted by **Bug Boys Termite & Pest Control** was and found to be lowest responsive and responsible bid, and meets all the requirements of the bid specifications, complies with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-3.1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 17:27 et seq., and is advantageous to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Contracting Officer has received favorable references on Bug Boys Termite & Pest Control and confirms that this contractor is qualified and possesses the experience to satisfactorily complete these services and recommends that the contract for aforementioned services be awarded to Bug Boys Termite & Pest Control; and

WHEREAS, it is further recommended that the contract with Bug Boys Termite & Pest Control shall be for a period of Two (2) years with the option, at the sole discretion of the Authority, to extend the contract for One (1) additional year upon termination of the original contract term. All multi-year contracts shall be subject to fund availability on a yearly basis. Total cost for each of year One and year Two is Fourteen Thousand, Six Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$14,655.60) each year for a total cost of Twenty-Nine Thousand, Three Hundred and Eleven Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$29,311.20) for both years; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that sufficient funds are available in the budget to cover these services which shall be encumbered from the operating budget at such time as services are rendered, as allowed under N.J.A.C. 5:30-5(b)-2. Amounts in excess of \$29,311.20 shall require adoption of Board Resolution authorizing the expenditure of additional funds; and

WHEREAS, the Authority reserves the right to add or delete sections of the work from the contract after award of the bid has been made, due to funding or other reasons and when the Authority acquires additional facilities to its portfolio, same shall be added to the contract by Change Order Resolution at the fee of One Dollar and Fifteen Cents (\$1.15) per apartment; and

WHEREAS, the prices bid for the various facilities shall not be adjusted due to deflection of any work or due to the variations of any quantity of work; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of the Housing Authority of Bergen County do hereby authorize a contract with Bug Boys Termite & Pest Control for the provision of Routine Monthly Pest & Rodent Exterminating Services for all the Authority's facilities, at the aforementioned amounts.
