Franklin Heights Apartments consists of (4) studio and (6) one-bedroom apartments.

In order to be eligible to apply, at least one household member/applicant must be 62 years of age or older. The total household annual gross income cannot exceed the following income limits;

Pre-applications received after the first 50 will be declined. The waiting list will close after the receipt of 50 completed, eligible pre-applications and will remain closed.

For those who need assistance obtaining access to or completing a pre-application the Housing Authority will make staff available at our main office One Bergen County Plaza 2nd Floor, Hackensack, NJ 07601 and Franklin Villa's Community Room located at 188 Franklin Street, Northvale, NJ 07647. Staff will be made available to assist with the completion of pre-applications beginning March 24th from 9:00 am until 3:30 PM, as needed until 50 pre-applications are received and deemed eligible. Please do not arrive to either the Housing Authority office or Franklin Villa Apartments before 8:30 am.

You are encouraged to complete your pre-application as soon as possible, as it will be placed on the waiting list based on the date and time that it was received.

Applicants who live, work, train, or attend school in Bergen, Hudson, Passaic, and Sussex counties will be given preference.
