**Absentee Ballot Application Instructions for the 2021
Town of Bladensburg October 4th Election**

Can I vote by absentee ballot? Yes, if you are a registered voter in Maryland and reside in the Town of Bladensburg. Only residents registered to vote in the Town of Bladensburg can vote in the Town Election.

How do I get an absentee ballot?

1. Complete and **Sign** the absentee ballot application and return it the Town Offices by deadline. The application must be received no later than seven days before the election. For this October 4, 2021 election it must be received by 5 p.m. on September 27, 2021.

2. If the Town of Bladensburg receives your completed application by the deadline and confirms that you are a registered voter, residing in Bladensburg, the Town will issue you an absentee ballot. Completed absentee ballots must be received by closing of the polls (8 p.m.) on October 4, 2021.
