Oath of Office

Policy: It is the policy of the Bladensburg Police Department for all sworn members, prior to assignment, to take and subsequently abide by an oath of office to uphold the Constitution of the United States and the State of Maryland.

Oath of Office

I, _____ (*name*), having been duly appointed as a Police Officer for the Town of Bladensburg, do solemnly affirm that I will bear true allegiance to the United States of America, the State of Maryland, and the Town of Bladensburg;
that I will support the Charter and Laws of Prince George's County and the Town of Bladensburg;
and that I will obey the orders of the Governor and the officers appointed over me according to the rules and regulations of the Bladensburg Police Department;
I will, to the best of my skill, judgment and ability, with diligence and faith, and without partiality or prejudice execute the office of Police Officer for the Town of Bladensburg, Maryland.

This General Order supersedes all other orders and memoranda in conflict therewith.
