Applicants for all positions must pass a background investigation as well as physical, psychological and polygraph testing. Applicants must demonstrate basic computer skills. Bilingual applicants are encouraged to apply.

Typical Duties:

Patrol assigned area to include all public and private businesses and residences, parking areas, and streets.

Direct vehicular traffic; enforce traffic laws; direct pedestrian traffic.

Enforce all applicable City, local, state and federal laws.

Investigate crimes; secure and protect the scene of a crime and the immediate area surrounding the crime scene so that no evidence is disturbed.

Make arrests of persons observed or suspected of committing crimes.

Hold a Maryland Police Certification.
