
Budget Division:

The City of Boonville respectfully requests that the Department approve and work into the 2022 Budget the 3-Year Growth excess levy appeal in the amount of \$167,612. The City properly published notice of the appeal within the Budget Form 3 on September 24, 2021. Then, pursuant to IC 6-1.1-18.5-12, the City timely filed an appeal application on October 18, 2021 and indicated that the signed petition would follow upon approval from the Council. Upon submission of the application, the DLGF provided no indication that there was an issue with following up with the signed petition after October 19. Furthermore, there were no taxpayer objections to the appeal.

We believe that the City met the minimum requirements for filing an excess levy appeal before October 20 pursuant to IC 6-1.1-18.5-12 and therefore, the appeal should be approved and worked into the 2022 budget. Please reinstate appropriations that were cut from General, Park, and Building Authority after working in the appeal.
