Do You Know Where Your Child Is?

Curfew Ordinance goes in effect November 15, 2012

SUMMARY

The City of Boonville has passed a new curfew ordinance for children/juveniles that will take effect November 15, 2012. No child/juvenile, ages 15,16 and 17, shall be allowed in a public place between 1:00 a.m. through 5:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday, or after 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, or before 5 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, without parent (custodian), guardian or responsible adult.

Any child/juvenile under fifteen (15) years of age will not be allowed in a public place after 11:00 p.m. or before 5:00 a.m. any day without a parent (custodian), guardian or responsible adult.

The penalty for first offense will be \$25.00 plus court costs; second offense \$100.00 plus court costs; and third offense \$200.00 plus court costs.
