

Buckingham County Electoral Board Meeting

January 11, 2022

The Electoral Board met in the basement conference room of the Administrative Complex on January 11, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. Board members Rick Caldwell and Larry Davis and Director of Elections/Registrar, Lindsey Taylor were present. Chairman, Rick Caldwell, called the meeting to order. Larry Davis read the minutes of the previous meeting which were approved.

Logistics and Accuracy (L&A) Testing was conducted on the CAP and Early Voting machines for the March 1st election. Testing was completed at 10:00 a.m.

Lindsey updated the Board on old and new business. Carry-over funds from the 2021 budget can be used to buy more electronic poll books. We will later determine the number we will have the funds to purchase. The Board will request either a full-time assistant or more part-time employees to assist Lindsey with the increasing work load. These funds would come out of the next budget period and would have to be approved by the Board of Supervisors.

The Board discussed the new redistricting and how it will affect the Officers of Election. Some will not be living in the precinct in which they work.

Training for the Commonwealth Attorney election will be held on February 22, 2022.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
