

Buckingham County Electoral Board Meeting

February 2, 2022

The Electoral Board met in the basement conference room of the Administrative Complex on February 2, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. All Board members and the Director of Elections/Registrar were present.

Chairman, Rick Caldwell, called the meeting to order. Secretary, Larry Davis, read the minutes of the previous meeting which were approved.

The Board agreed that all members would remain in their current positions for the coming year.

The upcoming budget was discussed. The Board agreed that there is a need for a full-time Assistant Registrar with a possible salary of \$32,240. This will be contingent upon the approval of county officials. The Board also approved the purchase of twenty (20) electronic poll-books. This would cost approximately \$32,000. These expenditures would be included in the new budget, however, there are unspent funds in the current budget that could be used.

The slate of potential Officers of Election was approved by the Board.

Training for the March 1, 2022 Special Election will be held on February 22 at 2:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs are required to attend.

Curdsville Community Center is requesting more money for roof repairs. We will look into this.

Lindsey Taylor gave the Board legislative updates and possible changes to election procedures. Redistricting information for elections must be completed by March 21, 2022.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:10 p.m.
