

**Buckingham County Electoral Board Meeting**  
September 9, 2021

The Electoral Board met in the basement conference room of the Administrative Complex on September 9, 2021 at 8:45 a.m. Board members Rick Caldwell, Larry Davis, and the Director of Elections/Registrar were present. Chairman, Rick Caldwell, called the meeting to order. Larry Davis read the minutes of the previous meeting which were approved.

Lindsey Taylor, Director of Elections/Registrar, updated the Electoral Board on old business and addressed several items of new business.

- Regional training was held in Richmond on August 31, 2021.
- The Electoral Board is no longer permitted to pick up ballots from drop boxes on election day.
- Electronic poll books, which were ordered for early voting, have not arrived yet.
- Training for early voting will be held on September 14, 2021.
- The budget rollover request was approved.
- The Board decided not to allow Sunday voting during the early voting period.
- The first meeting for redistricting will be held on September 9, 2021. Lindsey will be a part of this work group.
- Special elections for Commonwealth Attorney and District 6 School Board will need to be held in the future.
- Officer training for the November election will be held on October 19, 2021.
- The request from Curdsville Community Center to repair the leaking roof was approved by the Board. The estimated cost is \$1,500.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 a.m.

Following the meeting, Logistics and Accuracy (L & A) Testing was conducted in preparation for the November election. Testing was completed at 11:00 a.m.
