Cyclist struck by vehicle on Weiland Road in Buffalo Grove

Buffalo Grove, IL – At approximately 7:28 a.m. this morning, Wednesday, September 6, Buffalo Grove police and firefighters responded to a crash involving a vehicle and a cyclist on Weiland Road near Newtown Drive. Preliminary investigation indicated that a 13-year-old male on a bicycle was in the crosswalk when he was struck by a vehicle traveling northbound on Weiland Road. The driver of the vehicle, a 66-year-old Wheeling resident, remained on scene and is cooperating with authorities.

The 13-year-old bicyclist received treatment at the scene and was transported to Lutheran General Hospital by Buffalo Grove paramedics with non-life-threatening injuries. No charges have been filed at this time. The case is currently under investigation by the Buffalo Grove Police Department's Traffic Unit, along with the Major Crash Assistance Team.

Buffalo Grove Police remind motorists that school is back in session. Drivers should slow down and be alert for children in crosswalks and school zones.
