Buffalo Grove Police Arrest Northbrook Man for Sexual Assault

Buffalo Grove, IL – Anthony N. Lamonica, 40, of Northbrook, was arrested on sexual assault charges on January 11, 2019, which stemmed from an incident dating back to April of 2018.

On January 8, 2019, the Lake County State's Attorney's Office approved two charges of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Assault, both Class X felonies, based on an investigation which spanned nearly eight months. An arrest warrant was issued, and Lamonica turned himself in to investigators three days later on January 11.

The female victim told investigators she had first met Lamonica on a dating application (app) in 2017, but did not reconnect with him until April of 2018, the time of the alleged assault. The woman, in her 30's, agreed to go on a date with Lamonica where they attended dinner and then returned to her home in Buffalo Grove, where the alleged assault occurred.

Lamonica was transported to the Lake County Courthouse where he was given a bond of \$500,000. He posted the required 10-percent and was released to await his next court date of February 1, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in room T110.
