

Paying Your Taxes

Online using <https://www.carroll-county.net>

At participating banks in Carroll County from May 17th, 2021, through September 1st, 2021. Please bring your bill's payment coupon.

By mail using a check to Carroll County Treasurer, PO Box 198., Mt. Carroll, Ill. 61053. Please do not mail cash. Mail your payment at least five days prior to the due date, since payments not postmarked by the due date will incur 1.5% per month interest. Your cancelled check will serve as your receipt. If you need a written receipt, send a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your payment.

In person check at the Carroll County Treasurer, 301 N. Main St., Mt. Carroll, IL, Mon.-Fri., 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Please have your completed check with your bill or payment stubs.

Always write your Permanent Index Number (PIN) on your check and use the correct payment stub.

We do not accept personal checks after September 27th, 2021. Between Sept. 28th and Nov. 3rd, 2021, we accept the following checks in our office and by mail:

- Bank and mortgage company checks
- Title company checks
- Attorney "trust account" checks
- Certified and cashiers checks
- Money orders

Property taxes not paid in full by 4:30 pm November 3rd, 2021, will be offered for sale. Call the Carroll County Clerk at (815) 244-0221 for the total amount due to redeem taxes.

The last day to pay online is Oct. 22nd, 2021. The last day to pay all other ways is 4:30pm., Nov 3rd, 2021.

Helpful information

You will receive only one bill for your current property taxes, which are payable in two installments.

To avoid duplicate payments, ask your mortgage company if it pays your property tax bill.

New Carroll County property owners should refer to their closing papers or contact their attorney regarding payment of this property tax bill.

Avoid late payments. 1.5% per month interest is assessed after each due date. Taxes that remain unpaid will be published and sold with additional costs and interest.

Verify your Property Index Number (PIN). Payment on the wrong PIN cannot be refunded.

Payment details

Please make all checks payable to "Carroll County Treasurer" and write your PIN on your check. Include payment coupon with check. If you need a receipt other than your cancelled check, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope with your payment.

Checks returned by your bank for any reason will not be redeposited. Payment will be removed, and a \$25.00 fee will be assessed.

Publication Cost: An additional \$10.00 charge will be collected after September 27, 2021, on each unpaid bill to cover expense of delinquent tax publication and certified mailing.
