

Policy of Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Disability

Citizen Participation & Grievance Procedures Notice

The City of Carthage has adopted complaint and grievance procedures regarding its Texas Community Development Block Grant Programs (TxCDBG). Citizens may obtain a copy of these written procedures at City Hall, 812 W Panola St, Carthage, TX 75633 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 7:30 a.m to 12:30 p.m. on Friday. Citizens may also request the procedures be mailed to them by calling the city at 903-693-3868. These procedures outline the steps for a citizen to follow if s/he wishes to file a complaint or grievance about TxCDBG activities.

A person who has a complaint or grievance about any services or activities with respect to the TxCDBG project, may during regular business hours submit such complaint or grievance in writing to the City at 812 W Panola St, Carthage, TX 75633 or may call 903-693-3868. The City of Carthage will make every effort to respond fully to such complaints within fifteen (15) working days where practicable.
