*Plan Commission meetings follow the procedures outlined below. In the spirit of fairness to all parties, any of these procedures may be modified for a particular item at the discretion of the Chairman.*

2. Consideration of the minutes of the July 9, 2025 and September 10, 2025 Plan Commission meetings.
3. **Public Hearing and Action:** A request for a recommendation in support of re-approval of a tentative and final plat of subdivision for the Saunders Estates Subdivision proposed on the property addressed as **480 Saunder Road**.
