**Chairman Report:** There was much discussion and recommendation regarding new board members to replace the ones terming off. There was also discussion and recommendations regarding a new CROYA chair.

**Manager Report:** Todd reported changes at Activator Music Academy. Nick Cvijovic is no longer with Activator. Nick Christofalos is the point of contact at this time. Activator has a new piano and guitar teacher and they have hired a new supervisor.

Youth Report: Haley reported on the fun High School meetings that have been held. These include a mechanical bull and a magician. A St. Pat's celebration is planned for this week. Brier spoke about the successes of Peer Training and the excitement of a new location for the Spring Retreat, Phantom Ranch Bible Camp. Rick noted that SHYG has been going to this location for years. The accommodation will be cabins instead of dorms. There is a great group of adult chaperones on board, ten female and four male. Julia also shared that she is super excited about the retreat. She shared that the Founding Father Award applications were sent out last week and lots of seniors are applying.
