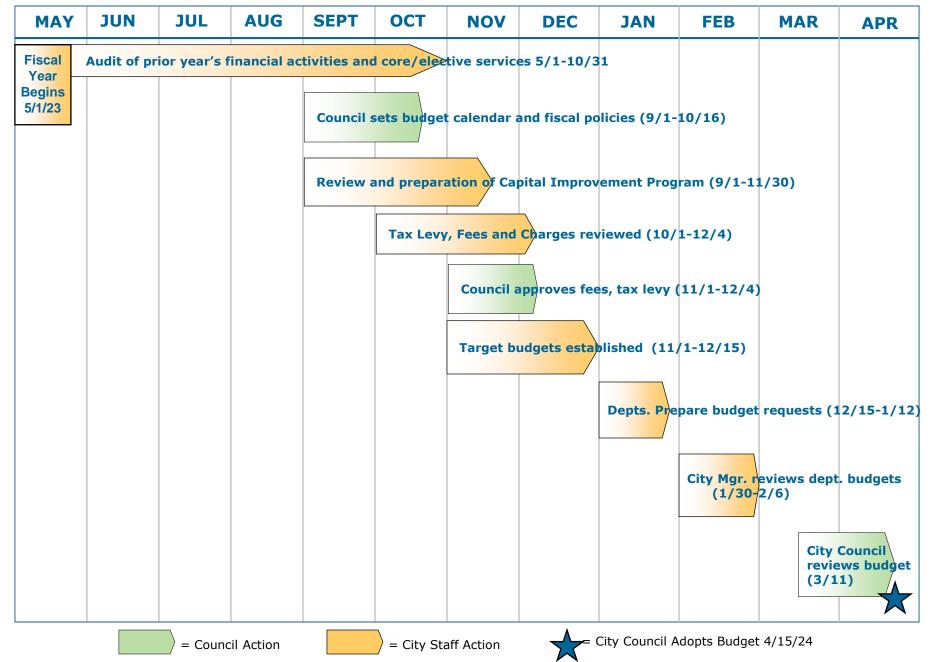

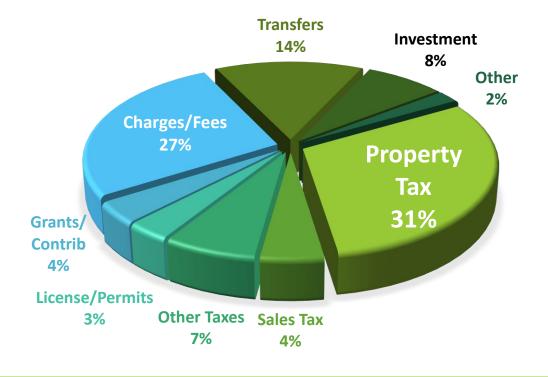

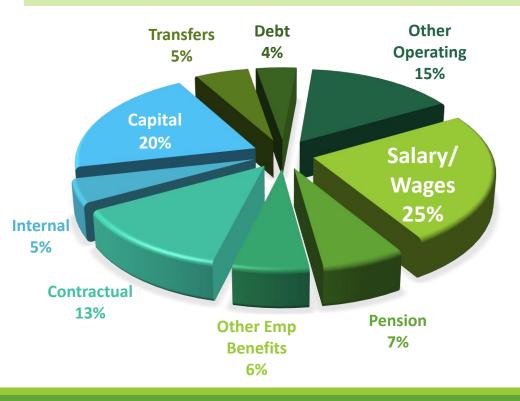
FY25 BUDGET City Wide Budget – All Funds

Personnel costs account for 38% of City-wide Expenses

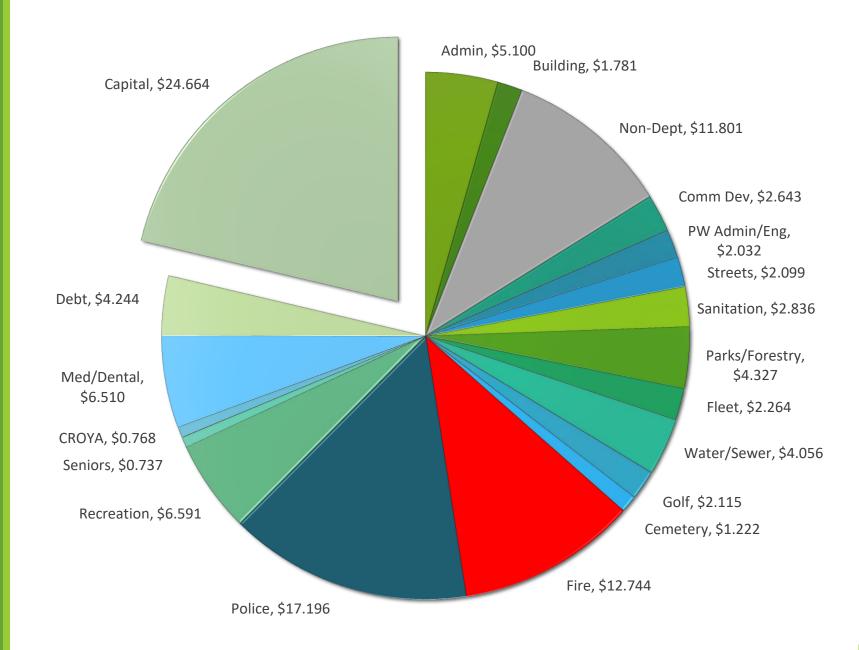

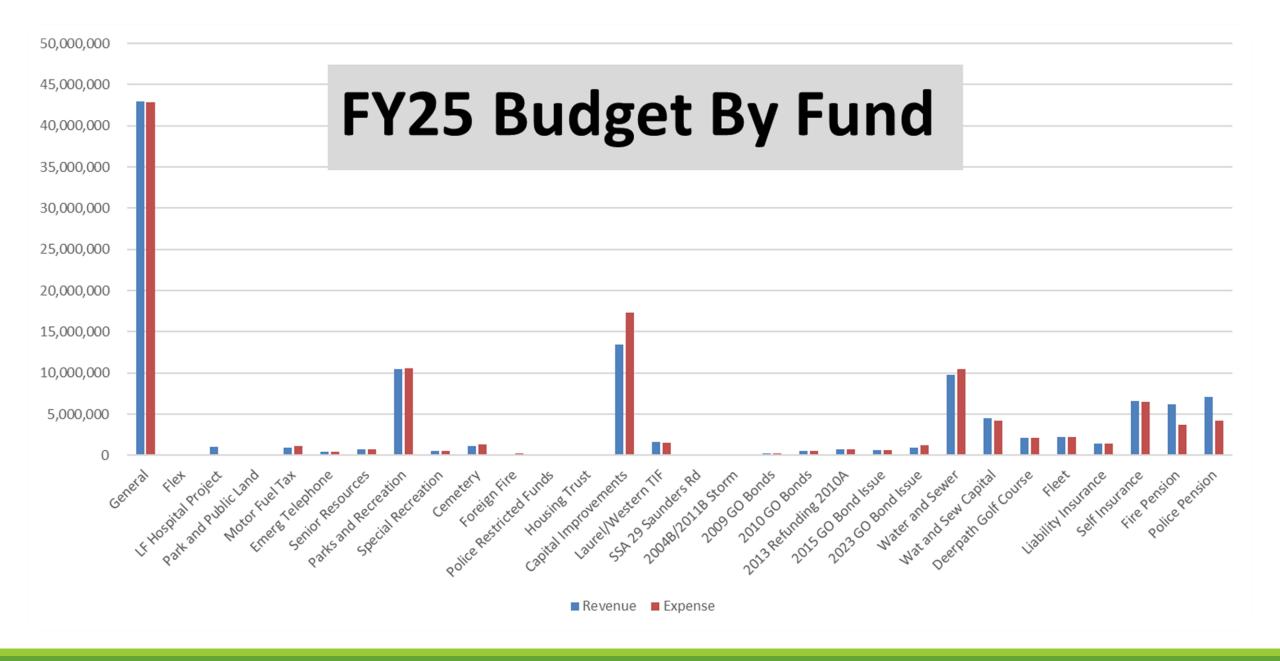

City-Wide Expenses by Function (in Millions)



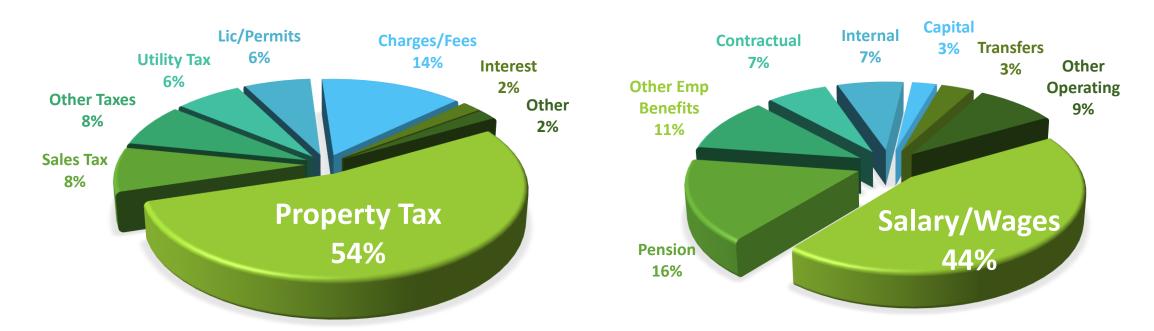


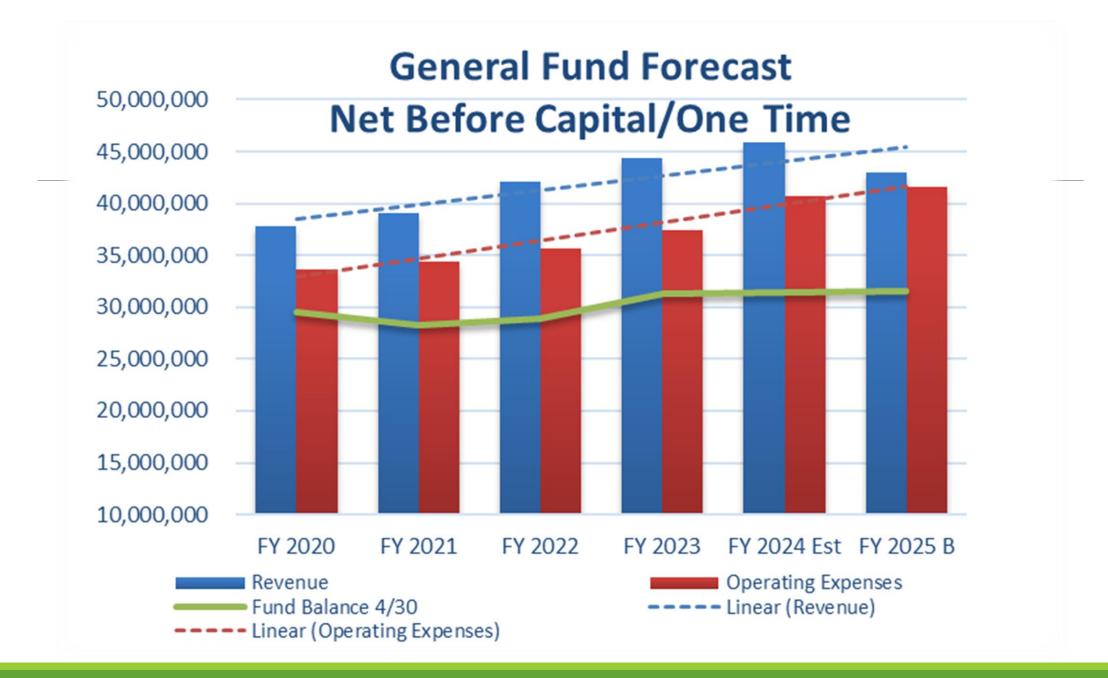
FY25 BUDGET General Fund
