<b>Summary</b>	Police conducted a traffic stop on a 2006 Land Rover after observing the vehicle speeding 81 mph in a posted 55 mph zone. When the officer approached the vehicle and spoke to the driver, who was identified as Sauceda-Rios, the officer was able to determine Sauceda-Rios did not have a valid driver's license. During the interview, the officer detected the odor of alcohol coming from Sauceda-Rios. When asked if he had been drinking alcohol prior to driving, Sauceda-Rios admitted to drinking one (1) beer. Sauceda-Rios was requested to complete some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on the speed at which Sauceda-Rios was traveling, the odor of an alcoholic beverage, his admission to drinking alcohol before driving, and his poor performance on SFSTs, Sauceda-Rios was placed under arrest for driving under the influence of alcohol and transported to the Public Safety Building for processing. Sauceda-Rios submitted to chemical breath testing which resulted in a reading of 0.95 BAC. Sauceda-Rios was released on bond and given a mandatory September court date.

<b>Summary</b>	While on routine patrol, a Lake Forest Police Officer located a vehicle parked in the area of Maywood and Highview Terrace. The vehicle contained one adult male and two juveniles. All three were dressed in dark clothing and when questioned why they were parked on a residential street at 3:00 am their stories did not match. While conducting interviews with the three subjects, additional officers canvassed the area and located multiple vehicles on Highview that were unlocked and appeared to have been entered and searched. A credit card was located in the possession of one of the juveniles that belonged to a resident who stated his vehicle had been searched and he identified his property. Police placed all three subjects into custody and transported them to the Public Safety Building for further investigation. Officers located nine (9) addresses in the area where unlocked vehicles had been entered and searched, with various items taken. Anderson was subsequently charged with Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor, released on bond, and given a September court date. The two juveniles were referred to Depke Juvenile Center on charges of Burglary to Motor vehicle and Possession of Stolen Property.

<b>Summary</b>	Police conducted a traffic stop on a 2007 Chevrolet Impala after observing the vehicle had no registration plates. When the officer approached the vehicle, he noted an adult passenger in the front seat and two children under the age of 3 in child seats in the rear of the vehicle. When the driver, Burgin, rolled down her window, the officer immediately smelled the odor of cannabis coming from the interior of the car and Burgin appeared lethargic and demonstrating signs of drug impairment. Burgin admitted to smoking cannabis 45 minutes prior to the traffic stop and she admitted to being "high". Burgin was requested to submit to standard field sobriety tests and, based on her performance, admitted drug use, and the officer's observations, Burgin was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Drug. Because police located several baggies that contained loose cannabis, she was also charged with Possession of Cannabis by a Driver. Burgin was transported to the Lake Forest Hospital for a drug test, which she refused to complete. Burgin was additionally charged with Child Endangerment. Burgin was released on bond and given an August court date.

<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a 911 call from a newspaper delivery person concerning a silver Hyundai stopped in the middle of the Inverleith Road with the driver appearing to be asleep at the wheel. Police observed a driver asleep, the car running and in park. Officers made several verbal attempts to wake the driver up with negative results. Upon waking up the driver, Officers observed him to be extremely confused and disoriented. Officers detected the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath and his eyes to be bloodshot and glossy. The driver was identified as Maximilian Steiner. Upon checking Steiner's license status, it was determined his license was suspended. <b>Summary</b>	<p>On Wednesday July 15, 2020, Lake Forest Police responded to seven calls concerning Burglaries to Motor Vehicles and one incident of a Theft of two (2) vehicles from one driveway. The burglaries took place at residences located near Old Elm Road, Ridge Road, and Waukegan Road. Homeowners reported unknown persons entered their vehicles, which were parked in driveways and in garages, and searched the vehicles for items to steal. In one incident, the homeowner found the garage door open and the door leading into the home from the garage slightly ajar. It was unknown what items were taken from any of the vehicles at this time. In the 1000 blk of Highland, a homeowner reported two (2) vehicles were stolen from their driveway. A 2017 Dodge Challenger and a 2009 Mercedes 350 were taken overnight after the offenders found both vehicles unlocked and the keys left in the vehicles. A Glock semiauto handgun was reported stolen along with the stolen vehicles. Police in Calumet City later located the Dodge Challenger abandoned in a parking lot. Lake Forest Police have no suspects at this time and, again, remind residents to lock their vehicles, remove keys and all valuables, including firearms, from the vehicles, and secure the valuables indoors.</p>

<b>Summary</b>	Lake Forest Police received a 911 call concerning a driving complaint of a black Lexus SUV that was driving erratically and may be DUI. Police were notified that the vehicle had pulled over to the shoulder on Rte. 41 and the male driver was slumped over the wheel. Lake Forest units located the vehicle driving on Rte. 41 and conducted a traffic stop. Officers spoke with the driver, Nguyen, about his driving and, while speaking with him, detected the odor of alcohol coming from him and they noted he was displaying signs of impairment. <b>Summary</b>	Lake Forest Police received a 911 call concerning a well-being check for 2 male subjects sleeping in their vehicle at Lou's Garage on Rte. 41. When officers arrived they found a red 2017 Hyundai Elantra parked in the second entrance south of Old Elm with the vehicle was running, lights on, music blaring, and the driver door ajar. Officers found the driver, Emmanuel Mendoza, sleeping with his head against the headrest. A second subject, located in the passenger seat, was also sleeping with his head forward hunched over. Officers were able to wake up Mendoza and the passenger after several minutes. Mendoza appeared confused, was slurring his words, demonstrated signs of alcohol impairment. Officers smelled the odor of alcohol coming from his breath. While speaking to Mendoza, officers observed an open beer in the center console and a six-pack of beer on the passenger floorboard. Officers had Mendoza exit the vehicle and perform some standard field sobriety tests. After finishing the SFST's, Mendoza was placed under arrest and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Open Transportation of Alcohol. Mendoza was transported to the Public Safety Building, where he was processed, submitted to chemical breath testing, and provided a sample, which resulted in a reading of 0.181 BAC. Mendoza was released on bond and given an August court date.

<b>Summary</b>	<p>Police responded to an address in the 1100 blk of Highland Ave. after receiving a report of a theft that occurred from a landscape trailer. The victim observed the subject exit a black Mazda sedan and enter the open landscape trailer. The victim then confronted the suspect, who was trying to steal a chainsaw from inside the trailer. The offender struck the victim with the chainsaw, causing him injury, and then fled the scene in the black Mazda. Lake Forest Detectives were able to identify Young as a possible suspect and the victim was able to identify him out of a line-up. Lake Forest Police worked with the Chicago Theft Task Force to identify the black Mazda, known associates of Young, and his current location. On 7/1/2020, multiple agencies were conducting surveillance on Young and two accomplices. The subjects were observed committing a similar type of theft, while driving the same black Mazda, in Franklin Park, IL. Young and two other suspects were taken into custody, in Franklin Park, and interviewed. Lake Forest Detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Young on the Lake Forest charges. He was arrested and transported to Lake Forest Police Department for processing. Young was held pending a bond hearing in Lake County.</p>
