| Summary | Police responded to a reported crash on Rte. 41 at the Lake Forest Hospital entrance. Officers located a black Nissan with heavy front-end damage, driven by Callejas, and a box truck driven by the victim. When officers attempted to interview Callejas about the crash, he refused to identify himself, was uncooperative with officers, and demonstrated signs of impairment. Police provided Callejas several opportunities to cooperate with their investigation but he refused. Callejas was subsequently arrested. When attempting to place Callejas in the rear of the squad car, he began actively resisting, attempted to bite one officer, and, once inside the vehicle, he used his feet to kick out the Plexiglas divider between the front and rear seating area and damaged the vehicle. Callejas was eventually situated in the squad car with one officer suffering a minor injury during his arrest. Callejas was transported to the Public Safety Building where he continued to be uncooperative with the booking process. Callejas was held pending transport to the Lake County jail for a bond hearing. | | | |

| Summary | Police responded to Highland Park Hospital to interview a victim of domestic battery. Officers met with the female victim and interviewed her regarding the domestic battery incident. Officers noted the female victim had signs of an injury, including a large swollen protrusion on her left jaw and a swollen area along her left eyebrow. Police were able to determine that a verbal argument escalated to a physical confrontation and the offender, who was identified as Eric Lundahl, struck the female victim repeatedly in the face and head. Police obtained statements from the victim, then went to the address on Estes where they located and interviewed the offender, Lundahl. Based on information obtained from the victim and witness, as well as the obvious physical signs of an injury due to a battery, Lundahl was arrested and charged with domestic battery. Lundahl was transported to the Public Safety Building and held pending approval of charges from the Lake County States Attorney. The LCSA approved Domestic Battery-Bodily Harm and Interfering with a 911 Call. Lundahl was held pending transport to the Lake County Jail for a bond hearing. | | | |

| Summary | Police responded to a reported accident with injury at Rte. 41 and Rte. 60 involving a semi-truck and a motor cycle. Police located the accident and observed a 2017 Honda CBR1000RR motorcycle with heavy damage and the driver sitting beside the motorcycle. The Lake Forest Fire Department arrived and assessed the motorcycle driver for injuries. LFFD transported the motorcycle driver, identified as Lott, to Condell Hospital for treatment. When police spoke to Lott at the hospital, they were able to determine through statements that Lott was speeding when he lost control of the motorcycle and crashed. Officers could also tell that Lott had an odor of alcohol on his breath and he was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment. Officers were advised that Lott's blood results indicated an alcohol level of 0.269 BAC. Lott was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, No Valid Driver's License, and Operating an Uninsured Motor Vehicle. | | | |

LaChapelle was asked to step out of the car and complete several field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive.
