Both parties were interviewed by officers to determine what happened. Based on statements by both parties and signs that a battery had taken place, Federighi was arrested and charged with domestic battery. Federighi was transported to the Public Safety Building where she was processed and held pending a bond hearing.

<b>Summary</b>	Police on routine patrol stopped and checked on a Pontiac Grand Prix that was parked on the shoulder of northbound Rte. 41 with its hazard lights flashing. The officer approached the vehicle and spoke to the driver, Thomas, about why he was stopped and his hazards were activated. During the conversation with Thomas, the officer noted the smell of alcohol coming from his breath and Thomas was demonstrating signs of impairment. Thomas was asked to exit his vehicle and perform some standard field sobriety test. Based on several factors, Thomas was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and transported to the Public Safety Building for processing.

<b>Subject(s)</b>	Tribble, Sean, male, age 41, 645 Buckingham Ct. Lake Forest IL 60045			
<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a 911 call at a residence in the 600 blk. of Buckingham Ct. for a reported domestic incident that had just occurred. Police located the female victim at the residence and discovered the male offender (Tribble) had fled in a Dodge Durango SUV prior to police arriving. Police interviewed the female victim, and a witness to the incident, and determined that during a verbal argument, Tribble became violent, smashed a kitchen chair, spat in the female victim's face, and threatened her with bodily harm. Tribble fled when police were called but was eventually located and taken into custody. The Lake County States Attorney was consulted and criminal charges of Domestic Battery were approved. Tribble was processed and held pending a bond hearing, after which Tribble was transported to the Lake County Jail for holding and an October court date was set.

<b>Subject(s)</b>	Tenorio, Crisoforo, male, age 61, 325 Ashland Ave., Highwood, IL 60040			
<b>Summary</b>	While on routine patrol, a Lake Forest Police Officer noted a silver Ford Explorer driving in an erratic manner on Rte. 41. After observing several moving violations, the officer conducted a traffic stop in the area of Old Elm and Buena Road. When the officer approached the vehicle and spoke with the driver, Tenorio, he was able to determine Tenorio only had an Illinois ID card and not a driver's license. The officer was able to confirm that Terorio's license was revoked for previous DUI's. Due to Tenorio demonstrating signs of impairment, the officer requested he step out of the car and perform some field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Upon completing the field sobriety tests, Tenorio was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence and Driving While License Revoked. Tenorio was transported to the Public Safety Building, where he was processed and held pending a bond court hearing on the felony charges.

<b>Subject(s)</b>	Diaz-Fulgencio, Josue, male, age 27, 841 Lenox, Waukegan, IL 60085			
<b>Summary</b>	Lake Forest Police received a driving complaint about a white Nissan Maxima that was driving northbound on Rte. 41 and was reported to be driving "all over the road". Officers located the vehicle in the area of Westleigh and Rte. 41 and after observing several violations, a traffic stop was conducted on Rte. 41, north of Deerpath. When officers spoke to the driver, identified as Diaz-Fulgencio, they noted he was demonstrating signs of some type of impairment. Diaz-Fulgencio was asked for his driver's license and when he opened his wallet, officers noted a small baggie containing a white substance tucked in the wallet. Officers were able to confirm Diaz did not have a valid driver's license at the time of the stop and, after having Diaz-Fulgencio submit to field sobriety tests, he was arrested for Driving Under the Influence-Drugs and No Valid Driver's License. Diaz-Fulgencio was transported to Lake Forest Hospital for drug testing. Diaz-Fulgencio was then transported back to the Public Safety Building, where officers field-tested the white powdery substance found in Diaz-Fulgencio's possession and it tested positive for cocaine. Diaz-Fulgencio was processed, released on bond, and given a mandatory October court date.
