Summary	Police were dispatched to a driving complaint on northbound Rt. 41 south of Westleigh Road concerning a Kia Soul that was stopped in the right lane and attempting to drive in reverse. Dispatch advised officers that the caller believed the driver was intoxicated. Police located the Kia on the side of Rte. 41 with two other vehicles blocking in the Kia. When officers spoke to the driver of the Kia, identified as Hapkowsky, they observed that he was demonstrating signs of some type of impairment. When asked, Hapkowsky thought he was currently in Milwaukee and he was trying to get home. Hapkowsky had trouble answering officer's questions and continued to demonstrate signs of impairment. Officers discovered a small blue baggie with a white powdery substance in Hapkowsky's possession and when asked what was inside the baggie and Hapkowsky stated heroin. Hapkowsky admitted to ingesting heroin prior to driving. Hapkowsky's driver's license was revoked for DUI and was currently under a summary suspension. Between Hapkowsky's phone and the phone case, officers discovered another six black plastic baggies which were full of a white powdery substance that field tested positive for heroin. Hapkowsky was charged with the above crimes, processed, and transported to the Lake County Jail where he was turned over to the custody of the Sheriff's Office.
