Summary	Police conducted a traffic stop on a white Ford Freestyle van after observing the vehicle driving at an extreme low speed on Rte. 41 and almost striking the concrete median barrier. Police spoke with the driver, identified as Julianne Fraser, about her driving and when asked for her driver's license, she was unable to provide one. While speaking with Fraser, officers noted her speech was very slow, her eyelids appeared to be droopy, and the officer observed her pupils to be very slow to react to the light. Fraser did admit to ingesting marijuana earlier in the day and taking her mother's valium and Lorazepam. Fraser was requested to complete several field sobriety test to determine her ability to drive. Based on Fraser's performance on the SFSTs, her driving, and her admitted drug use, she was arrested for Driving While Impaired. Fraser was transported to Lake Forest Hospital for DUI testing. Police transported Fraser to the Public Safety Building for processing and released her on bond with a mandatory January court date.

Summary	Police conducted a traffic stop on a 2002 Ford pickup after observing the vehicle commit multiple traffic violations; including driving 30 mph in a posted 55 mph zone. When officers approached the truck and spoke to the driver McGee concerning the reason for the stop, they immediately observed that McGee was demonstrating multiple signs of alcohol impairment. McGee admitted to not having a driver's license and officers confirmed it was currently revoked for DUI. McGee admitted to drinking 3-4 beers prior to being stopped and, based on the officers observations, they requested McGee perform some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on McGee's ability to perform SFST's and the officer's observations of McGee's driving and physical condition, he was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. McGee was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was processed and subsequently provided a breath sample that registered 0.139 BAC (0.08 is legal limit). McGee was held overnight pending a bond court hearing.
