Summary	Police responded to a traffic crash at Rte. 41 and Rte. 60 involving two vehicles. Police were notified one vehicle fled the scene southbound on Rte. 41 and the witness described the vehicle as having heavy damage. Police located a 2007 Toyota Highlander on the shoulder of Rte. 41 and identified Karpenko as the driver. During the crash investigation, officers noted Karpenko was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment. Karpenko was requested to complete field sobriety testing, and based on the officer's observations and Karpenko's demonstrated physical impairment, he was arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Leaving the Scene of an Accident. Karpenko was transported to the Public Safety Building, where he submitted to chemical breath testing and a result of 0.15 BAC. Karpenko was processed and released on bond with a mandatory March court date.

Summary	On Friday, February 12, 2021, Candice Shandor, 33, and Dakotah Beeter, 26, were arrested, and each was charged with two counts of felony burglary and one count of possession of a stolen vehicle. Lake Forest Police found the two at an Airbnb in Oakbrook Terrace, where police found evidence implicating the two in recent similar crimes in the area, authorities said. Lake Forest Detectives identified Shandor and Beeter as suspects after a January 18 traffic stop on a vehicle that had been stolen from 90 E. Franklin Place in Lake Forest. After getting a positive identification of Shandor and Beeter, officers presented their case to the Lake County States Attorney and obtained arrest warrants for both individuals. The McHenry County sheriff's office, Chicago Police Department, Illinois Department of Corrections, Oakbrook Terrace Police Department, and DuPage County sheriff's office all assisted Lake Forest Police in serving the warrants before finally locating the two offenders in Oakbrook Terrace. Shandor and Beeter were transported back to Lake Forest, where they were interviewed before being transported to the Lake County jail. Both subjects are being held at the Lake County jail on \$200,000 bail.

Summary	Police responded to a driving complaint from IDOT concerning a green sedan described as driving "all over the road" on Waukegan Road. Police located the 2020 Toyota Camry driven by Lopez parked in a driveway in the 1200 block of Waukegan Road. When they walked up to the vehicle and spoke to Lopez, they immediately smelled the odor of alcohol coming from her breath. Lopez was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment and had a hard time answering the officer's questions. Lopez thought she was in Calumet City when officers asked her where she thought she was. During the conversation with Lopez, dispatch notified officers that Lopez's driver's license was currently revoked. Officers requested Lopez complete some field sobriety tests to determine her ability to drive. Lopez agreed, completed the sobriety test, and, based on her performance, and the officer's observations, was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Driving While License Revoked. Lopez was transported to the Public Safety Building, where she was processed, provided a breath sample that registered 0.158 BAC, and released on bond. Lopez was given a March mandatory court date.

Summary	Police responded to a 911 call concerning a parked minivan blocking a driveway on Green Bay Road. The caller stated there was a female driver who appeared to be asleep at the wheel. Officers located a blue Chrysler minivan driven by Zalnierukynaite blocking a driveway. When officers located the vehicle and spoke to the driver, Zalnierukynaite, officers determined she demonstrated signs of alcohol impairment. When they requested she complete some field sobriety tests to determine her ability to drive, she refused to cooperate. When officers told her she was under arrest for DUI, Zalnierukynaite sat down on the road and refused officers' commands, and physically refused to be handcuffed.
