<b>Subject(s)</b>	Palmer, Alan, male, age 61, 1077 Coventry Dr. Lake Forest, IL 60045			
<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a 911 call concerning a disturbance at a restaurant located at 825 S. Waukegan Road. On arrival, officers located a male subject who was bleeding from the head standing outside the restaurant. Officers attempted to interview the male subject but he was uncooperative and appeared to be demonstrating signs of intoxication. While Lake Forest Fire Department personnel examined the male subject for injuries, officers interviewed other persons who were identified as witnesses and victims in the incident. Police were able to determine Palmer engaged in an unprovoked attack on several restaurant patrons when he walked into the restaurant and physically assaulting a man and woman who were waiting to be seated. Palmer was subsequently arrested and charged with Battery, released from custody and given a February court date.

<b>Subject(s)</b>	Juvenile male #1, age 17, Grayslake IL Juvenile male #2, age 17, Gurnee, IL			
<b>Summary</b>	Police conducted a traffic stop on a GMC Yukon after observing the vehicle had no operating brake lights. When the officer approached the vehicle and spoke to the juvenile driver, the officer immediately smelled the odor of cannabis coming from inside the vehicle. The driver admitted to not having a driver's license when asked to produce one. When the officer questioned the driver about the cannabis smell the driver produced a small bag of cannabis and a glass pipe with burnt cannabis in it. During further investigation the officer located a backpack filled with approximately 1 pound of psilocybin mushrooms packaged in 7 different bags. Officers located other controlled substances and paraphernalia in the juvenile's possession. The juveniles were brought to the Public Safety Building where they were turned over to their parents. The case will be referred to the Juvenile States Attorney for charges.

<b>Subject(s)</b>	Montoya, Julissa J., female, age 35, 3847 N. Sawyer, Chicago, IL 60618			
<b>Summary</b>	Police officers conducting routine patrol in the area of Woodland and McKinley located three vehicles: a Subaru, an Audi A4, and a Toyota Highlander, driving in a suspicious manner in the area of Sheridan Road at 3:15 am. Police suspected one or more of the vehicles were stolen and attempted to stop the vehicles but were only able to get the Toyota Highlander to stop. The Toyota was operated by Montoya and, based on her statements, officers were able to determine the Toyota was just stolen from 90 E. Franklin Place. During interviews Montoya admitted to being part of a crew that was responsible for the mail/package thefts from 1301 N. Western the week before and that all three vehicles officers attempted to stop were recently stolen vehicles. Lake Bluff Police located an abandoned 2007 Toyota Camry containing stolen mail in the 400 blk of Park Lane. Detectives checking the area located the stolen Subaru abandoned on Summit Ave near Westminster. The Camry was identified as the suspect vehicle from the mail theft at 1301 N. Western. Montoya was charged and held overnight pending a bond court hearing. Police determined the Subaru, Audi, and Toyota Highlander had been stolen from 90 Franklin after the offenders forced entry into the garage and found those vehicles unlocked with the keys in the vehicles. Police recovered two of the three stolen cars plus the additional Toyota Camry that was stolen in Chicago.

<b>Subject(s)</b>	Campbell, Joseph J, male, age 25, 1165 Larkdale Row, Wauconda IL 60084			
<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a reported two-car traffic crash at the intersection of Waukegan Road and Deerpath. When officers met with the driver of a white Honda who had rear ended a black Jeep, officers determined the Honda driver had a strong odor of alcohol on his breath. The driver of the Honda was identified as Campbell and, during the crash investigation, officers noted he displayed several signs of alcohol impairment. When questioned he admitted to drinking prior to driving. Campbell was requested to complete some field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on the officers observations, Campbell's driving, and his performance on the SFST's, he was arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Police located cannabis and drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. Campbell was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was processed. He submitted to a breath test and his BAC was recorded at 0.182. Campbell was released on bond and given a February court date.

<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a report of a vehicle driving on Rte. 41 with no headlights, was reported to be "all over the road" and almost struck a Highland Park Police squad that was assisting a tow truck. Police located a 2012 Infinity matching the caller's description and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Officers approached the vehicle to speak to the driver, identified as Ball. While speaking with Ball, officers noted the smell of alcohol coming from her breath and, when asked, Ball admitted to leaving a party in Chicago. Ball was requested to complete some field sobriety tests and, based on the observations of the officer and Ball's driving, she was placed under arrest and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. <b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a driving complaint concerning a vehicle that had left the roadway and struck a sign and several trees before it continued driving in an erratic manner. Officers located the vehicle in the area of Western and Westleigh Road. Police attempted to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle but the driver failed to stop and continued to elude police at a high rate of speed. Officers were able to stop the suspect from driving when it pulled into a driveway on Ridge Road. Officers noted the Toyota Camry had severe damage to the front and rear bumpers, it was smoking and the air bags had deployed. Officers made contact with the driver, Belsanti, and determined he was under the influence of some substance. Officers noted Belsanti had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath, his speech was slurred, and he appeared to be confused. Police attempted to question him about his driving. When he attempted to leave the scene he was placed under arrest for DUI. Officers also located drug paraphernalia and controlled substances in Belsanti's vehicle, which were taken into custody and inventoried for evidence. Belsanti was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was interviewed, charged with multiple traffic and non-traffic violations, and held overnight pending a bond hearing and transport to the Lake County Jail
