Summary	Police responded to a reported domestic incident that occurred in the 300 block of East Deerpath. Officers located a 19-year-old female victim who stated she was involved in a domestic incident with her boyfriend (Mayorga). During the argument, the victim reached into Mayorga's car to retrieve her phone when Mayorga grabbed her arms and started driving away, dragging the victim. The victim fell out of the car once the car turned onto Westminster. During the fall, the victim hit her head on the pavement, rolled under the car, and her arm was run over by the rear tire. While speaking to the victim at the scene, officers on patrol in the area spotted Mayorga's vehicle. They attempted to conduct a traffic stop to take Mayorga into custody. Mayorga fled from police and was last seen westbound on Deerpath, driving in excess of 100 mph. The victim was transported to Lake Forest Hospital for treatment. Palatine Police later located Mayorga, and he was taken into custody. Mayorga was interviewed, processed, and held for bond court on numerous domestic-related charges. Mayorga was subsequently transported to the Lake County Jail and held on a \$250,000 bond.

Summary	Police responded to a single-vehicle crash in the 300 block of Onwentsia Road. Police located a black BMW 330i that had been involved in the crash, and officers noted all airbags had been deployed as a result of the crash. Officers located Gantz at the scene. He stated no one else was involved, and he was driving at the time of the crash. While officers spoke to Gantz, they noted the smell of alcohol coming from his breath, and he was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment. Gantz was transported to the Public Safety Building, where he was given the opportunity to perform standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on Gantz's performance on the SFSTs, his driving, and the officers' observations of his physical condition, Gantz was arrested and charged with driving under the influence of alcohol. Gantz was processed, released on bond, and given a mandatory January court date.

Summary	Police conducting stationary radar on Westleigh Road observed a Ford pickup traveling at a high rate of speed. Officers used the squad radar to verify the vehicle was driving at 63 mph in a posted 35 mph zone. Police conducted a traffic stop on the pickup and spoke with the driver, Kemper, about the reason for the traffic stop. During the conversation with Kemper, officers noted he was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment, and the smell of alcohol was coming from his breath. When questioned, Kemper admitted to drinking two (2) Long Island Ice Teas prior to driving. Officers then requested Kemper to exit the vehicle to complete some standardized field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Kemper was subsequently arrested for Speeding 63/35 and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Kemper was transported to the Public Safety Building. He was processed, given a chemical breath test which resulted in a reading of 0.144 BAC, and released on bond with a mandatory January court date.
