Officers were able to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle on Sheridan and Arbor in Lake Bluff. When officers approached the vehicle to speak with the driver (Morales-Manjarrez), they noted she was attempting to cover up several beer cans. While speaking to Morales-Manjarrez about the reason for the traffic stop and requesting her driver's license and insurance, officers noted she was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment, and the odor of alcohol coming from her breath was strong. Morales-Manjarrez was requested to step from the vehicle and perform some standard field sobriety tests to determine her ability to drive. Following the SFSTs, Morales-Manjarrez was placed under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, No Valid Driver's License, Driving the Wrong way on the Roadway, and Illegal Transportation of Alcohol. During a search of her vehicle, officers located an open and partially full beer in the center console and an additional 14 empty beer cans in the vehicle. Morales-Manjarrez was given the opportunity for a portable breath test which registered 0.237 BAC. Morales-Manjarrez was processed and released on bond with a mandatory March court date.

Daniels was arrested and transported to the Public Safety Building for further questioning and screening of felony charges by the States Attorney's office. Daniels was subsequently charged with Aggravated Identity Theft with Persons Over 60 Years Old, Identity Theft, Forgery, and Deceptive Practice. Daniels was taken to the Lake County Jail for a bond hearing and was placed under a \$200,000 bond. Highland Park Police confirmed that they are working on a similar case involving McBryde and other stolen checks.

<b>Summary</b>	<p>Police responded to a 911 call regarding a hit-and-run crash at Edgewood and Noble Avenue intersection. The victim stated that a pickup truck attempted to pass her stopped vehicle and struck the left rear corner of her vehicle. The victim was able to get a description of the vehicle and the plate number and provided Taylor's identity as the driver's name due to his participation in a youth hockey league. When officers checked Taylor's driving history, they noted that Taylor was currently suspended for DUI. One of the officers on the scene confirmed that they arrested Taylor for DUI and Hit &amp; Run in December of 2022. Police concluded their traffic crash investigation and could not locate Taylor at his residence. Taylor was subsequently contacted and met with police on January 31 at the Public Safety Building. Officers noted that Taylor drove himself to the Public Safety Building on January 31, a second violation for Driving While License Suspended. Taylor was informed he was under arrest for Driving While License Suspended (2 counts) and Leaving the Scene of an Accident. During an interview concerning the traffic crash, Taylor stated he was aware he struck a vehicle and was even able to describe the make and color of the vehicle. He noted that he was in a hurry to get a child to a youth event so he did not stop and speak with the driver. He was processed, released on bond, and given a mandatory March court date.</p>
