The male stated he was homeless and thought the home was empty and left. Lazaretti then saw the subject rummaging through a dump truck on the property and discovered the power to the house was cut. Further investigation by police indicated a shed on the property was pried open, and the bed of a pickup truck had been rummaged through. Cross was located by police on the bike path behind the residence and initially gave police a false name. The second attempt at a bond hearing led to Cross becoming disruptive and eventually biting a sheriff's deputy.
