<b>Summary</b>	Lake Forest Officers assigned to the Internet Crimes Against Children task force developed intelligence that Fahey was seeking to have conversations with juveniles. Investigators confirmed that Fahey was using a chat phone application to have conversations with what he believed was a 15-year-old female but was, in fact, an investigator with ICAC. The chat progressed and Fahey asked to meet up with the 15-year-old female for the purpose of committing a sexual act. Fahey agreed to meet up at a location in Lake Forest on Friday night at 11:45 pm. He was met by Lake Forest Police officers and taken into custody. The case was reviewed by the Lake County States Attorney's Office who approved the following charges: Indecent Solicitation of a Minor Class 3 Felony and Traveling to Meet a Child Class 3 Felony. Fahey was processed and held overnight then transported to the Lake County Jail on 7/1/2023 for a bond hearing. Fahey appeared before the Honorable Judge Lofthouse, the bond was set at \$300,000.

<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a reported single-vehicle crash at the intersection of Waukegan Road and Everett Road. Officers located a black Chevrolet truck stopped partially in the right lane of southbound Waukegan Road and partially in the grass. Officers observed tire tracks showing a path entering from the south end of Gavin Ct, with extensive damage to trees and shrubbery approximately 10-15 feet west of the roadway and leading right to the stop point of the vehicle. Police located the driver, identified as Colin Ward, walking outside the vehicle. Officers observed extensive damage to the vehicle including shrubbery stuck in the front grill, the interior airbags were deployed, the passenger side had extensive scrapes and dents, a missing door handle, and the mirror was knocked off. The front passenger tire was unseated and damaged. Officers detected the odor of alcohol coming from Ward's breath and he was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment. When asked, Ward admitted to drinking two 16oz. beers prior to driving. Police requested that Ward complete some standard field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive. Based on Ward's performance of the SFSTs, the admitted drinking prior to driving, and his demonstrated impairment, Ward was arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Ward was transported to the Public Safety Building where he was processed, released on bond, and given a July court date.

<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to the area of Rte. 41 and Old Elm Road after receiving a 911 call concerning a single-vehicle crash at that location. Police located a dark-colored Jeep Cherokee on Route 41, north of Old Elm Rd. The Jeep's rear passenger side corner bumper was in the roadway. When the officer walked up to the vehicle he noticed the driver, Minor, appeared to be asleep and the vehicle was still in Drive. When officers were able to get Minor's attention and ask him what happened, Minor was unable to explain the events that happened prior to when his vehicle came to a stop. Minor explained he had a medical condition that required him to take medications, so the Lake Forest Fire Department was dispatched to check his condition. During the interaction with Minor, officers noticed he repeatedly fell asleep and had to be awakened when asked questions. Also, a faint odor of an alcoholic-based beverage could be detected emanating from his breath. Minor was transported to Lake Forest Hospital for further observation. Based on information obtained about Minor's blood alcohol levels, officers were able to determine it was 0.168 or twice the legal limit. Officers also determined that Minor's driver's license was currently revoked, and he did not have insurance on his vehicle. Minor was issued citations for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Driving While License Revoked, and Operating an Uninsured Motor Vehicle. Minor was later processed, released on bond, and given a mandatory July court date.
