When officers conducted a pat down of Williams, they located a plastic bag containing cannabis hidden in her waistband. Williams was transported to the Public Safety Building, where she was processed, released on bond, and given a mandatory May court date.

<b>Summary</b>	Police conducted a traffic stop on a white Honda Pilot after observing the driver commit a traffic violation and throw an object from the vehicle. Officers spoke to the driver concerning the reason for the stop. Officers determined the driver was 17 years old, he was demonstrating signs of alcohol impairment, and officers could smell a strong odor of alcohol coming from his breath. Officers had the juvenile perform several field sobriety tests to determine his ability to drive, which he failed. Officers arrested the teen and transported him to the Public Safety Building for processing. The teen driver was issued citations for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Illegal Transportation of Alcohol. He was processed and provided a breath sample which read 0.103 BAC. The teen was released on bond and turned over to his father.

Police located the Nissan and, after stopping the vehicle, officers spoke with the driver, Luria-Carlos, about the crash. While speaking to Luria-Carlos about the crash, officers requested she produce her driver's license and proof of insurance for her vehicle. Luria-Carlos could not provide either item and officers confirmed that she did not have a valid driver's license or vehicle insurance. <b>Subject(s)</b>	Wilson, Martell, male, age 26, 216 N. Laramie Ave., Chicago, IL 60644			
<b>Summary</b>	Police conducting traffic enforcement duties on Rte. 41 attempted a traffic stop on an orange Ford Escape after observing the vehicle driving 93 mph in a posted 55 mph zone. As police attempted to stop the vehicle, the officer noted several lane violations indicating the driver was possibly impaired on some substance. Officers were able to stop the vehicle and speak to the driver, who was identified as Wilson. When speaking to Wilson, officers noted the smell of alcohol coming from his breath, and he was demonstrating signs of impairment. As the officer attempted to get Wilson to exit the Ford Escape, Wilson ignored the officer's commands, started the car, then drove off-headed north on Rte. 41 at a high rate of speed. Lake Bluff Police quickly located the Ford Escape after it crashed at the intersection of Rte. 41 and Washington, and they took Wilson into custody. Wilson submitted to chemical breath testing, which registered a blood alcohol reading of 0.101 BAC, which is over the legal limit. Police located several plastic bags containing cannabis along with a digital scale commonly used to weigh cannabis prior to selling it. Wilson was transported back to the Public Safety Building. He was processed and charged with Speeding 93/55, Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding, Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Possession of Cannabis by Driver. The Lake County States Attorney approved the felony charge of Fleeing & Eluding, and Wilson was held in jail pending transport to the Lake County Jail.

<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to a complaint of juveniles drinking alcohol at a residence in the 800 block of S. Cherokee in Lake Forest. When police arrived at the scene, they observed several juveniles who were drinking beer, found several juveniles who had the smell of alcohol on their breath, and observed multiple juveniles running from the property into the woods to evade officers. Officers received consent from the homeowner to enter the residence, where officers observed open beer cans in several areas. Police cleared the house and found juveniles hiding throughout the house. Police attempted to gather all the juveniles, aged 14-15, in one area of the house while dealing with parents who suddenly showed up on scene to claim their child being detained by police. Police identified those teens that were intoxicated and those that were not. Police contacted parents not already on the scene and requested they come to the address to retrieve their child. Police spoke with parents, and Administrative Hearing tickets were issued to those juveniles who consumed or possessed alcohol. An Administrative Hearing ticket was given to Weiss for Social Hosting. Police later responded to a report of a damaged fence at a neighbor's home that was likely broken when juveniles climbed over during their flight from police.

<b>Summary</b>	Police responded to Academy Road after receiving an Alert Notification from a FLOCK license plate recognition camera that detected a stolen Jeep entering the Academy Woods subdivision from Rte. 60. Police quickly located the Jeep leaving Lake Forest Academy property and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Officers identified Servin as the driver and sole occupant in the Jeep. Officers detained Servin, and after properly identifying him, officers determined that the Jeep was confirmed stolen from Round Lake Park on 3/4/2023. Servin's driver's license was revoked. Servin also had an outstanding warrant from Lake County for Failure to Appear on DUI charges. Officers located opened Modelo beer cans, an opened Hennessy glass bottle, a knife, a lunch bag containing 40.2 grams of raw cannabis, unused plastic baggies, and two weight scales commonly used for weighing and packaging cannabis.
