Summary	On April 19, 2023, at 9:29 am, Lake Forest Police responded to the area of Academy Drive and Route 60 after officers received a FLOCK® ALPR camera alert concerning a silver Mini Cooper linked to a registered child sex offender driving towards Lake Forest Academy. Officers located the suspect vehicle on Academy Drive as it approached Rte. 60 and conducted a traffic stop. Officers identified Glenn P. Stephens, male, white, age 68, of 1302 Appletree Lane, Libertyville, Illinois as the driver of the Mini-Cooper and confirmed he is a current registered sex offender for a 2008 conviction for Indecent Solicitation of a Child. After questioning Stephens at the scene and he denied ever being on the school property, he was released at the scene. Officers began investigating Stephens' whereabouts to determine if he had entered Lake Forest Academy property in violation of his status as a registered child sex offender. Lake Forest Police were able to confirm this through video surveillance. Stephens drove past signs indicating Lake Forest Academy property, was observed driving onto school property, and subsequently stopped in front of the school fitness center. All activities are in clear violation of his sex offender status. The Lake County States Attorney's Office approved the charge of Presence of Registered Child Sex Offender on School Grounds (class 4 felony), and an arrest warrant was approved with bond set at \$200,000. On May 16, 2023, Vernon Hills Police received a FLOCK® ALPR camera alert on the same Mini-Cooper driven by Stephens and that there was an active warrant for his arrest. Without incident, Stephens was taken into custody by VHPD and transported to Lake County Jail, where he will be held pending a bond hearing.
