RESOLUTION NO. 5 OF 2022**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CLARION COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE 2022 CLARION COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE
PLAN UPDATE, DATED FEBRUARY 7, 2022.**

Whereas, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Act of 1968, P.L. 805, No. 247 (hereinafter referred to as the “MPC”), requires that municipalities and counties review their comprehensive plan for future land use and growth management at least every ten years; and

Whereas, the MPC further requires that the comprehensive plan contain a statement of objectives of the county concerning its future development, including topics related to housing, transportation, land use, community facilities and services, natural resources, historic and cultural resources, economic development, parks and recreation, and public utilities;

Whereas, the Clarion County Planning Department and Clarion County Planning Commission, as the designated Planning Agency for the County, has prepared the proposed comprehensive plan known as the 2022 Clarion County Comprehensive Plan Update, with the active participation of County staff, residents, businesses, and others having a stake in the future growth and development of the County, including the Project Steering Committee; and

Whereas, the Project Steering Committee and County Staff have participated in the development of the Comprehensive Plan Update, which has specific goals and priorities for the County to accomplish over the next decade according to the following theme areas: Promoting Economic Growth and Development, Sustaining Healthy, Livable Communities, Expanding Opportunity with Infrastructure Improvements, and Supporting Fun Places to Play: Parks and Recreation;

Whereas, public input was obtained from various public meetings held throughout the process and an online survey as well as through the official 45-day public display and comment period, along with the required public meetings and hearings, including the following:

- a) A public meeting sponsored by the Planning Commission held on January 19, 2022; and;
- b) A public hearing hosted by the Board of Commissioners on January 25, 2022.

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Clarion County is of the considered opinion that the 2022 Clarion County Comprehensive Plan Update should be adopted as part of the County’s official comprehensive plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved, that the Board of Commissioners of Clarion County does hereby approve the adoption of the 2022 Clarion County Comprehensive Plan Update dated February 7, 2022.
