#### General Rules

- 1. No Smoking in or within 25 feet of Clarion County vehicles
- 2. No eating or drinking, unless approved due to medical reason
- 3. No littering in or from the vehicle
- 4. Be courteous to other riders
- 5. Seatbelts must be worn in all vehicles
- 6. Inform the driver if you need assistance to and from the curb
- 7. All children aged 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult age 18 or older
- 8. Illegal activities, verbal abuse, or physical abuse will not be tolerated. These actions may lead to immediate dismissal from the vehicle. This behavior will also be reported to the referring agency, which may revoke authorization for transportation services.
- **9.** No weapons are allowed on any transport provided by CATA.

# Transportation for Persons with Disabilities (PwD)

Funded by PennDOT

Clarion County Transportation offers disabled residents aged 18 to 64 years curb-to-curb transportation at a cost discounted by 85% thanks to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. Qualifying passengers pay 15% of the trip cost.

A completed eligibility and registration form is required, along with a certification of disability.

### CAN SOMEONE GO WITH ME?

An escort may accompany anyone on a trip without cost when independent travel is not possible due to age, disability, language barrier, or when the escort is verified necessary for the recipient to secure medical examinations and treatment. Notify us when scheduling if an escort is necessary.

Note: Our escort policy applies.

## How Is Transportation Provided?

Clarion County Transportation provides curb-to-curb services, which means you are expected to get to the curb to be picked up.

Services are 'shared ride,' meaning you will usually be riding with other passengers. Depending on where you need to go, we will provide your rides using accessible mini-vans, transits, or buses.

Rides must be scheduled at least one day in advance for destinations within the county and two days in advance for destinations in surrounding counties within the service area.

When you schedule, we will give you a half-hour pickup window. Please be ready to go and watch for your ride during this time. The driver will wait a maximum of five (5) minutes. Call us if you'll be late so we can notify the driver.



## How Do I Apply For Services?

Complete an eligibility and registration form, available at the office listed below, or call us and we will record the required information for you and mail it to you for your review and signature.

You can also apply online a www.apply.FindMyRide.penndot.pa.gov

Before you can start scheduling rides, you will need to

- ✓ sign the form
- ✓ provide an acceptable proof of age
- ✓ provide a certification of disability

Once your application is received and reviewed, you will be notified of your eligibility to participate.
