General Rules

- No smoking in or within 25 feet of Clarion County vehicles.
- No eating on the vehicle unless approved due to medical reasons.
- No littering in or from the vehicle.
- Be courteous to other riders.
- Seatbelts must be worn in all vehicles.
- Inform the driver if you need assistance to and from the curb.
- All children aged 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult age 18 or older.
- Illegal activities, verbal abuse, or physical abuse will not be tolerated.
 - These actions may lead to immediate dismissal from the vehicle.
 - This behavior will also be reported to the referring agency, which may revoke authorization for transportation services.
- No weapons are allowed on any vehicle.

What We Need

Welcome to the services provided by MTM for Clarion County Transportation. As a new consumer we will need some documents from you before we can begin scheduling your rides within Clarion and surrounding counties.

Regulations require us to keep proof of age on file for all clients aged 65 and older who are using funds from the Pennsylvania Lottery or the Area Agency on Aging.

Acceptable documents for proof of age are as follows:

- PA Driver's License
- PA Photo ID Card
- Birth Certificate
- Armed Forces DD-214*
- Passport

*Veterans must provide proof of honorable discharge to access services through this program.

These documents may be copied and sent to our office, or they can be brought in, and we will copy them for you.

When to Schedule

Scheduling Hours: M-F 7AM - 5PM

Service Hours: M-F 5:30AM - 6PM

Once your information is received you may begin scheduling rides by calling our office at (814) 226-7012 or toll free at (800) 672-7116. You should call us as soon as possible once you have your appointment and no later than noon the day before the trip within Clarion County. We will need the address of the facility and an estimate of how long your appointment will last.

For trips outside of Clarion County, you must call by noon at least two days before your scheduled appointment.

Emergency, evening, and weekend transport is not provided by MTM.

If your trip gets cancelled for any reason, you must notify us immediately.

Service is curb to curb. Passengers needing assistance from their home to the vehicle are required to have an aid/escort accompany them at no additional cost. The driver is required to stay with the vehicle.

MTM has the right to request the rescheduling of appointments to coordinate schedules in the same general area.
