## **BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPOINT JIM FERRYMAN AS BOARD PRESIDENT**

(Costa Mesa, CA) – In its last meeting of the calendar year on Thursday, December 20, the Costa Mesa Sanitary District (CMSD) Board of Directors nominated and appointed Jim Ferryman to serve as President for the next two years. President Ferryman has served as a District board member since 1988. He served as Board President in 1994, 1998, 2005, 2012 and is now entering his fifth term in this capacity.

President Ferryman has a long history of community involvement serving various organizations such as past President of the Newport Mesa Unified School District and Chairman of the Orange County Sanitation District. He was chosen as the Costa Mesa Chamber of Commerce “Man of the Year” in 1992.
