APRIL 1 DEADLINES

HOMESTEAD EXEMPTIONS



Now is the time to apply for exemptions. If you owned and occupied your house as of Jan 1 then you may be eligible for a variety of money saving exemptions. Check our [exemptions page](#) and apply by April 1.

MOBILE HOMES

All mobile homes must have a current Cobb County decal (location permit) prominently displayed. To obtain a 2021 decal, visit [cobbtax.org](#) to pay taxes and the decal will be mailed to you. 2021 Tax Bills were mailed in January and payment is due April 1.

PROPERTY

Our **Property Tax Division** bills, collects and distributes ad valorem property taxes for real property, personal property (boats, planes, business property, etc.), heavy duty equipment, mobile homes and public utilities.

In addition, this division also processes homestead exemptions and conducts tax sales. They are also responsible for preparing the tax digest each year.

MOTOR VEHICLE

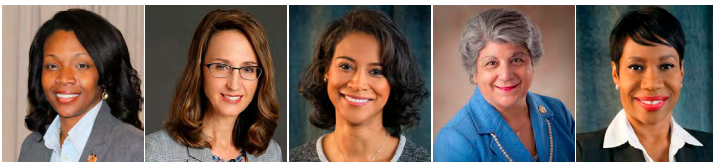
Our **Motor Vehicle Division** bills, collects and distributes ad valorem property taxes or title ad valorem taxes for motor vehicles, trailers, motor homes, motorcycles/scooters and tractor trailers under IRP.

In addition, this division also operates as a tag agent on behalf of the Georgia Department of Revenue. As such, they enforce state and local laws regarding vehicle registration requirements, insurance, emissions and mobile home ownership. This includes collecting fees associated with those regulations.

Revenue received is distributed to all taxing authorities on a weekly basis. Taxes are collected not only for the county, Department of Revenue, and Board of Education, but for all six cities in Cobb County.
